



Hazel Shawl

Materials

6 skeins of 1.8 (50 g) of Summer Cloud col. 02

Circular needle 31.5 inches (80 cm),
US size 13 (9 mm)
Stitch markers

Sizes

One size

Measurements

Width: 59.1 inches (150 cm)
Length, middle of work: 33.5 inches (85 cm)

Gauge

13 stitches and 15 rows in stockinette stitch
on 4 inches (10 cm).

Pattern information

The edge of the neck is knitted so the ridges are in continuation of each other. Work 3 knit stitches for the edge on each row.

You increase after and before the edges and you increase on each side of the middle stitch every 2nd row.

The increases are yarn around needle on the purl row and they are knitted knitwise and through the back loop respectively on the knit row. This provides an even middle stitch throughout the work.

The pattern consists of various pattern charts.

Abbreviations and explanations:

1 increase through the back loop: Knit the horizontal loop between the stitches through the back loop.

1 increase: Knit the horizontal loop between the stitches knitwise.

1 bobble: knit 5 stitches in the next stitch, turn, slip 1 stitch, purl 4, turn, slip 1 stitch, knit 2, work 2 stitches together knitwise, turn, slip 1, purl 1, work 2 stitches together purlwise, turn, slip 1 stitch, work 2 stitches together knitwise, pull the slipped stitch over = 1 stitch.

Lace pattern:

1. row, knit row: *yarn over, work 2 stitches together knitwise*, repeat from * to *.

2. row, purl row: purl.

Note: due to the increases you should knit the following right side rows (knit rows) like this:

3. row, knit row: yarn over, work 2 stitches together knitwise like this:

Knit until you reach the yarn over on the 1. row, (the stitch is the 2nd stitch on the left needle and the yarn over is the 1st stitch) work 2 stitches together knitwise.

4. row, purl row: purl

Repeat 3. and 4. row.

Pattern

Cast on

Cast on 3 stitches and knit 6 rows knitwise.

Twist your work and knit 3 stitches straight up along the side, twist your work and knit 3 stitches up along the cast on edge = 9 stitches.

Mark the increases

Place a marker after 3 stitches, 1 marker on each side of the middle stitch and a marker 3 stitches from the edge.

Continue to knit 3 stitches in the beginning and the end of each row.

Increase after the 3rd stitch from each side and on every side of the middle stitch.

Increase with a yarn around needle: you work a yarn around the needle on the purl rows (the wrong side), and on the knit rows (the right side), you knit and knit through the back loop respectively like this: knit the yarn around needle knitwise on each side of the 3 edge stitches, and knit through the back loop on each side of the middle stitch.

Start the increases - stockinette stitch

1. row, wrong side: knit 3, move the marker, yarn over, work purl stitches until you reach the marker, yarn over, move the marker, purl 1, move the marker, yarn over, work purl stitches until you reach the marker, yarn over, move the marker,
Knit 3 = 4 increases = 13 stitches.

2. row, right side: knit 3, move the marker, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, knit stitches until you reach the yarn around the needle, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, move the marker, knit 1, move the marker, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, knit stitches until you reach the yarn around the needle, knit the yarn around the needle, move the marker, knit 3.

Repeat these 2 rows until you have 33 stitches. Finish with a right side row.

NOTE: From now on, the markers are no longer mentioned in the pattern.

1. Pattern chart - bobble stitch

1. row, wrong side: knit 3, yarn over, knit 13, yarn over, purl 1, yarn over, knit 13, yarn over, knit 3 = 37 stitches.

2. row, right side: knit 3, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, knit 13, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, knit 1, work the yarn around needle through the back loop, knit 13, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, knit 3.

3. row, wrong side: k3, yarn over, p15, yarn over, p1, yarn over, p15, yarn over, k3 = 41 stitches.

4. row, right side: k3, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k1, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k1, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

Work row 1-3 as previous, with increases = 49 stitches.

8. row, right side: k3, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k6, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k6, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k6, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k6, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

Work row 1-3 as previous, with increases = 57 stitches.

12. row, right side: k3, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k5, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k5, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k5, 1 bobble, k5, 1 bobble, k6, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

Work row 1-3 as previous, with increases = 65 stitches.

NOTE: From now on, the number of stitches are no longer provided, but the increases continue until the shawl is finished.

2. Pattern chart - seed stitch

1. row, right side: k3, work the yarn around needle knitwise, work seed stitch: *k1, p1* until you reach the yarn around the needle, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, work seed stitch: *k1, p1* until you reach the yarn around the needle, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

2. row, wrong side: k3, yarn over, work seed stitch: *purl over knit and knit over purl* until you reach the middle stitch, yarn over, p1, yarn over, work seed stitch until you have 3 stitches left, yarn over, k3.

Repeat these 2 rows until you have 13 rows of seed stitch. Finish with a right side row.

Next row, wrong side: k3, yarn over, work knit stitches until you reach the middle stitch, yarn over, p1, yarn over, work knit stitches until you have 3 stitches left, yarn over, k3.

3. Pattern chart – lace pattern

Work 2 rows of stockinette stitch, with increases just like previously.

Lace pattern:

1. row, right side: k3, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, work lace pattern: *yarn over, work 2 stitches together knitwise* until you reach the yarn around the needle before the middle stitch, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, work lace pattern: *yarn over, work 2 stitches together knitwise* until you reach the yarn around the needle before the edge stitches, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

2. row, wrong side: k3, yarn over, work purl stitches till you reach the middle stitch, yarn over, p1, yarn over, purl till you reach the edge stitches, yarn over, k3.

3. row, right side: k3, work the yarn around needle knitwise, work lace pattern*) until you reach the yarn around the needle before the middle stitch, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, k1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, work lace pattern until yarn around the needle before the edge stitches, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

Repeat the 2. and 3. row 3 times in total.

Work 2 rows of stockinette stitch, with increases just like previously.

Next row, wrong side: k3, yarn over, knit stitches to middle stitch, yarn over, p1, yarn over, knit stitches until you have 3 stitches left, yarn over, k3.

4. Pattern chart – stockinette stitch

Work 11 rows of stockinette stitch, with increases like previously. Finish with a right side row.

Next row, wrong side: k3, yo, knit stitches to the middle stitch, yo, p1, yo, knit stitches until you have 3 stitches left, yo, k3.

5. Pattern chart – bobble stitch

Work like the 1st pattern chart. End with a right side row.

Next row, wrong side: k3, yo, knit to the middle stitch, yo, p1, yo, knit stitches until you have 3 stitches left, yo, k3.

6. Pattern chart– seed stitch

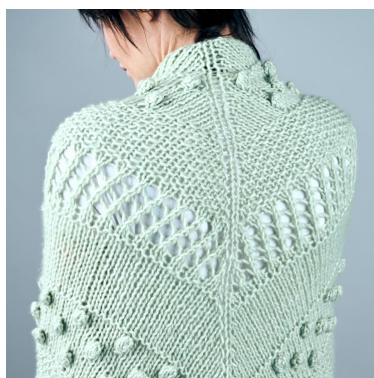
Work like the 2nd pattern chart. End with a right side row.

Edge in knit-ridges (2 rows of garter stitch)

Next row, wrong side: k3, yo, knit to the middle stitch, yo, p1, yo, knit stitches until you have 3 stitches left, yo, k3.

Next row, right side: k3, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, knit to the middle stitch, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, p1, work the yarn around the needle through the back loop, knit until you have 3 stitches left, work the yarn around the needle knitwise, k3.

Repeat these 2 rows until you have 3 ridges on the right side. Finish with a wrong side row. Bind off knitwise from the wrong side
