



# Ada Summer Top

## Materials

2 (2) 3 (3) skeins of 100 g Twister Solid,  
Hobbii color 110  
32" Circular needle US 2 ½ (3 mm)  
DPNs US 2 ½ (3 mm) for the icord

## Sizes

S (M) L (XL)

## Finished Measurements

Width at the bottom rib:  
17 ¾ (18 ½) 19 ¼ (20) in  
45 (47) 49 (51) cm  
Length:  
21 ¼ (21 ½) 22 (22 ½) in  
54 (55) 56 (57) cm

## Gauge

26 sts per 4" / 10 cm  
30 rws per 4" / 10 cm

## Pattern information

The top is knit from the bottom up, in the round on a circular needle in stockinette. There are increases throughout which forms an inverted A-shape.

The piece is divided at the armholes and knit flat for the front and back pieces.

ES = edge stitch.

On the right side, slip the first st with the yarn held behind.

On the wrong side, slip the first st with the yarn held in front.

The shoulders are sewn together with kitchener stitch at the end.

An icord is added along the neck line.

## Body

CO 232 (244) 252 (264) sts. Join in the round on the circular needle and work in rib \*k2, p2\* until the piece measures 2" (5 cm).

Place a marker on either side to indicate the side seams. 1 at the beginning of the round and 1 after 116 (122) 126 (132) sts.

### **Increases**

Increase on either side of the markers up to the arm holes. Then continue increasing on the sleeve edges.

Knit the YOs to form a lace edge.

1. Rnd 1: k1, YO, k to 1 st before the next marker, YO, k2, YO, k to 1 st before the next marker, YO, k1.
2. Rnd 2: k all sts
3. Rnd 3: k all sts
4. Rnd 4: k all sts
5. Rnd 5: k all sts
6. Rnd 6: k all sts

Repeat rnds 1-6 until the piece measures 12" (30 cm).

### **Front piece**

Work flat on the circular needle. Continue increasing every 6<sup>th</sup> row, but work 1 Edge stitch on every row.

1. Row 1: 1 ES, k1, YO, k until there are 2 sts remaining, YO, k2.
2. Row 2: 1 ES, p all sts
3. Row 3: 1 ES, k all sts
4. Row 4: 1 ES, p all sts
5. Row 5: 1 ES, k all sts
6. Row 6: 1 ES, p all sts

Repeat rows 1-6 until there are 166 (172) 176 (182) sts on the row and the piece measures 19 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (50 cm).

Place the first 52 (54) 57 (59) sts aside and place 62 (64) 62 (64) sts aside for the neckline separately, place the last 52 (54) 57 (59) aside.

### **Back piece**

Work the same as the front piece
