



Rainbow Kitchen Set

No. 2003-192-8202

Materials

Kitchen towel: 2 skeins of Rainbow (3.5 oz / 100 g) Dishcloth: 1 skein of Rainbow (1.8 oz / 50 g) Col 58, 57, 54, 22, 31, 39

Needle size US 4 / 3.5 mm

Gauge

1 pattern repeat of 20 stitches measures 2.6" / 6.5 cm (width) x 2.4" / 6 cm (height) per stripe.

Measurements

Kitchen towel: approx 10.2" x 14.2" / 26 x 36 cm **Dishcloth**: approx 10.2" x 10.2" / 26 x 26 cm

Zigzag pattern

Kitchen towel: Pattern divisible by 20 + 1 stitch Dishcloth: Pattern divisible by 18 +1 stitch

About the pattern

The kitchen towel and dishcloth are worked in the flat.

Color order

Red Orange Yellow Green Blue Purple



Elaboration

Knit 3 together (k3tog): Slip 2 stitches knitwise (as if you were to knit them), knit 1 stitch, pass over the loose stitches.

Pattern

Kitchen towel

Co 81 sts with the red yarn and knit 1 row.

Work in pattern and stripes like this:

Pattern row 1 (RS): Work 2 sts in 1 st, repeat *k8, k3tog, k8, inc1 (pick up the bar between the sts), k1, inc1* until 20 sts remain, k8, k3tog, k8, work 2 sts in 1 st = 81 sts. Pattern row 2 (WS): K all sts.

Change colors every 22 rows. When all 6 colors are worked, the kitchen towel measures approx 14.2" / 36 cm.

Strap

At the middle of the kitchen towel, a strap is crocheted.

Chain 30 sts. Stitch them onto the kitchen towel where the strap begins. Turn the work and work 1 single crochet in each chain around the strap.

Dishcloth

Co 73 sts with the red yarn and knit 1 row.

Work in pattern and stripes like this:

Pattern row 1 (RS): Work 2 sts in 1 st, repeat *k7, k3tog, k7, inc1 (pick up the bar between the sts), k1, inc1* until 18 sts remain, k7, k3tog, k6, work 2 sts in 1 st, k1 = 73 sts. Pattern row 2 (WS): K all sts.

Change colors every 10 rows. When all 6 colors are worked, the dishcloth measures approx 10.2" / 26 cm.

Do not cut off the yarn. Instead, place the last loop on the crochet hook.

Edge

Work single crochet sts along the even side. Cut the yarn and weave in the end. Do the same on the other side. Cut the yarn and weave in the end.
