



Elderberry Shrug

No. 2004-192-7200

Materials

4 (5) 5 (6) 6 skeins of 50 g Summer Cloud color 07

Knitting needles US 10 ½ (7 mm) 3rd needle for knitting the back together

Sizes S (M) L (XL) XXL

Finished Measurements

Height at mid back: 12 ½ (13 ¼) 14 (15) 15 ¾ in 32 (34) 36 (38) 40 cm Half wing span: 26 (26 ¾) 26 ¾ (27 ½) 27 ½ in 66 (68) 68 (70) 70 cm

Measure your half wing span (from wrist to mid chest) and choose the size that matches best.

Pattern information

The shrug is knit in 2 parts: from arm to the back. The pieces are then knit together at the mid back.

Gauge

14 sts and 17 rows in stockinette = 4"/ 10 cm

M1: Pick up the bar between 2 sts, inserting the left needle from front to back and knit through the back to twist the st.

Lace pattern over 18 sts:

Row 1, WS: knit all sts. Row 2, RS: *YO, k1 *, repeat 3 times, *k2tog*, repeat 6 times, *YO, k1 *, repeat 3 times. Row 3: purl all sts Row 4: knit all sts. Repeat these 4 rows.



Left sleeve and back

CO 36 (38) 40 (42) 44 sts and knit flat on a circular needle.

Work in stockinette on both sides and the lace pattern over the middle 18 sts:

Row 1, WS: p 9 (10) 11 (12) 13, k 18, p 9 (10) 11 (12) 13.

Row 2, RS: k 9 (10) 11 (12) 13, YO, k1 *, repeat 3 times, *k2tog*, repeat 6 times, *YO, k1*, repeat 3 times, k 9 (10) 11 (12) 13.

Row 3: purl all sts

Row 4: knit all sts.

Repeat these 4 rows until the piece measures 2"/ 5 cm.

Begin increases

Increase every 8 (8) 8 (6) 6 rows, but only on one side:

RS: K until there are 2 sts remaining, M1, k 2.

Increase in this way until there are 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 sts of stockinette on the right side, 18 sts in lace pattern and 17 (19) 21 (23) 25 sts of stockinette on the left side = neck = 44 (47) 50 (53) 56 sts.

Work evenly until the piece measures 26 (26 $\frac{3}{4}$) 26 $\frac{3}{4}$ (27 $\frac{1}{2}$) 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 66 (68) 68 (70) 70 cm. End with Row 4 in the pattern.

Adjust the pattern for your own measurements here if needed. Set these sts aside.

Right sleeve and back

Work the same as the left, but with the increases on the opposite side, as follows: **RS:** k = 2, M1, k to the end of the row.

Assembly

Lay the 2 pieces with right sides facing each other, k2tog with 1 st from each piece and bind off at the same time with an extra needle.

Sew the sleeve seams together approx. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 40-42 cm from the cast on edge.

Edge

Pick up stitches around the opening. Turn the work and bind off in knit st from the WS.
