EK4 - Thick cardigan in Mayflower Easy Knit.

Size:	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)	XXXXL
Chest measurement in cm:	100	(110)	120	(130)	140	(150)	160
Length in cm:	64	(65)	66	(67)	68	(69)	70
Color 04, balls:	5	(5)	6	(6)	7	(7)	7
Needles:	US 17/UK 000 (12 mm)						
Quality:	Mayflower Easy Knit. 53 % Wool, 47 % Acrylic, 80 m pr. 100 gram.						
Gauge:	Average. Horizontal: 7 sts = 10 cm. Vertical: 10 rows = 10 cm.						

To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crocheting.

It is a good idea to read through the pattern before starting, and also to make a swatch and wet block it.

Back.

- 1: On needles US 17/UK 000 cast on 36(40)44(48)52(56)60 sts and knit 3 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.
- 2: Continue in stockinette until the work measures 63(64)65(66)67(68)69 cm. Fasten off the middle 15(16)17(18)19(20)21 sts for the neck and finish each side apart.
- 3: Towards the neck side fasten off 1x1 sts and fasten off the remaining sts for the shoulder.
- 4: Knit the other side mirrored

Front.

- 1: On needles US 17/UK 000 cast on 18(20)22(24)26(28)30 sts and knit like the back until the front piece has the same length as the back.
- 2: Do not fasten off for neck, but fasten off all sts at once.
- 3: Knit another front piece.

Sleeve.

- 1: On needles US 17/UK 000 cast on 22(24)26(28)30(32)34 sts and knit 3 cm ribbing, knit 1 purl 1. Applies to all sizes.

- 2: After the ribbing edge continue in stockinette, while increasing in both sides on every 6th row to 34(36)38(40)42(44)46 sts. Knit until the sleeve measures 44(45)46(47)48(49)50 cm or the desired length.
- 3: Knit another sleeve.

Seaming.

- 1: Sew together over the shoulders, start by the sleeve-side so you use the same amount of sts from the shoulder on the front and the shoulder on the back. The rest of the sts on the front piece sticks out and makes a collar.
- 2: Sew the sleeves in, not too tight.
- 3: Sew the side and sleeve hems.
- 4: Weave in ends.
- 5: Wet block the cardigan.

NB: There are no edges on the front pieces or in the neck, since the alternating thickness of the yarn makes a nice wavy edge.
