



Elatius Long Cardigan

No. 2003-193-8768

Materials

Circular needle US size 10.75 (7 mm), 31.5 inches (80 cm) for Fur Lux

Circular needle US size 8 (5 mm), 31.5 inches (80 cm) for Baby Wool

17 (19) 21 (23) skeins of 1.8 oz. (50 g) of Fur Lux from Go Handmade, color: bear

2 (2) 2 (2) skeins of 1.8 oz. (50 g) of Baby Wool, color 05

Stitch holders

7 buttons, metal buttons with eyes, 0.8 inches (20 mm), color: black.

Sizes

S (M) L (XL)

Measurements

Width: 18.9 (19.7) 20.5 (21.3) inches (48 (50) 52 (54) cm)

Length: 31.5 inches (80 cm), all sizes.

Knitting gauge

10 stitches on 4" (10 cm)

20 rounds on 4" (10 cm)

Pattern information

The cardigan is knitted back and forth on a circular needle.

The edges and neckline are knitted in double strands of Baby Wool.

Lastly, the knitted patch pockets are knitted the same way.

Pocket

Body

Cast on 100 (108) 112 (116) sts.

Knit back and forth in rib *knit 1, purl 1* until your work measures 1.96 inches (5 cm).

Knit back and forth in garter stitch until your work measures 5.9 inches (15 cm).

Now, put sts on hold for pockets like this:

Pockets

Knit 12 sts of garter stitch, knit 12 more knit sts, but put these on hold, continue until you have 24 sts left on the rnd, knit 12 sts and put them on hold, knit the rest of the rnd.

On the next rnd, knit up new sts using the chain cast on technique over the sts you put on hold.

Continue back and forth in stockinette stitch until your work measures 21.7 inches (55 cm).

The work is divided in back and front pieces = 25 (27) 28 (29) sts for the front piece, and 50 (54) 56 (58) sts for the back, and 25 (27) 28 (29) sts for the front piece.

Front piece

Knit each piece straight up for 5.1 inches (13 cm) as you knit back and forth on a circular needle.

Right shoulder

On right side rows decrease for the neck like this:

1. row, right side: bind off the first 4 sts and knit the rest of the row.
1. row: knit sts.
2. row, right side: knit 1, knit 2 sts together through the back loops, knit the rest of the row.
3. row: knit sts.

Repeat row 3 and 4 until you have made (5) 6 (5) 6 decreases = (16) 17 (19) 19 sts on shoulder.

Knit straight up until your work measures 31.5 inches (80 cm).

Put the sts on hold.

Left shoulder

On wrong side rows decrease for neck like this:

4. row, wrong side: bind off the first 4 sts and knit the rest of the row.
5. row: knit over each stitch.
6. row, wrong side: knit 1, knit 2 sts together through the back loops, knit the rest of the row.
7. row: knit over each stitch.

Repeat row 7 and 8 until you have made (5) 6 (5) 6 decreases = (16) 17 (19) 19 sts on shoulder.

Knit straight up until your work measures 31.5 inches (80 cm).
Put the sts on hold.

Back

Knit straight up for 7.1 inches (18 cm). Bind off the middle 14 (16) 14 (16) sts.
Decrease for the neck by knitting the first 2 sts on the row together as you did with the front piece.

2 times in total in each side = 18 (20) 18 (20) bound off sts = (16) 17 (19) 19 sts on each shoulder.

Put the sts on hold.

Assembly

Sew the shoulders together using the kitchener stitch.

Sleeves

Knit approx. 48 (50) 52 (54) sts up along the armhole. Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd under the armhole.

The sleeves are knitted in the round in garter ridges: 1 rnd of knit stitches, 1 rnd of purl stitches.

Continue in the round in garter stitch as you decrease on each side of the marker:
Knit to 2 sts prior to the marker, work 2 sts together through the back loops knitwise, knit 2 sts together.

Repeat the decreases every 6th rnd, 7 times in total = 34 ((36) 38 (40) sts.

Knit until the sleeve measures 17.7 inches (45 cm).
Bind off.

Now, knit using the Baby Wool

Knitted patch pocket

The patch pocket is knitted in two threads of yarn. Place the 12 resting sts back on the circular needle and pick up 2 sts on each side of the 2 x 12 resting sts = 48 sts.

Knit in the round on a circular needle using the magic loop technique until the patch pocket measures 6.7 inches (17 cm). Bind off using the 3 needle bind off technique.

Knit one more patch pocket.

Neckline

Knit up sts along the neckline and knit 1.6 inches (4 cm): *knit 1, purl 1*.

Left rib edge

Knit/pick up sts along the edge from the right side. Skip approx. every 3rd stitch, so the edge doesn't become too loose compared to the cardigan itself.

On the first row, knit the sts like this: *knit 1 s through the back loop, purl 1 through the back loop* to bind off the holes from the pick up-edge.

Work rib *knit 1, purl 1* until the edge measures 1.2 inches (3 cm).

Bind off in rib.

Sew on 7 buttons, divided over the rib edge.

Right rib edge

Knit up sts along the edge from the right side. On the first row, knit the sts like this: *knit 1 s through the back loop, purl 1 through the back loop* to bind off the holes from the pick up-edge.

Work rib *knit 1, purl 1* until the edge measures 0.6 inches (1.5 cm).

Button holes

Place 7 stitch markers next to the buttons on the left front edge. Knit the button holes where you placed the markers like this: *work 2 sts together, yarn over*.

Continue in rib until your work measures 1.2 inches (3 cm). Bind off in rib.
