Miniature Unicorn

No. 1009-193-1707

Height: 4" (10 cm)
Skill level: Beginner

Crochet hook: B/C – 1/2 (2,5 mm)

Materials: embroidery needle & black yarn,

scissors, fiber filling.

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4

How much yarn do you need?

White (001): 1 skein

Light Coral (050): 1 skein **Light Purple (040):** 1 skein

Delicate Light Blue (026): 1 skein

Old Rose (046): 1 skein

Abbreviations:

- **ch** = chain
- **sc** = single crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- MR = magic ring
- [...] = no. of stitches
- (...) = no. of rounds
- Inc = Increase, work 2 sc in same stitch
- **Dec =** Decrease, work 2 sc together
- **dc** = double crochet

Head

In white (001)

R1: 6 sc in a mr	[6]
R2: *inc* 6x	[12]
R3: *1 sc, inc* 6x	[18]
R4: *2 sc, inc* 6x	[24]
R5: *3 sc, inc* 6x	[30]
R6: *4 sc, inc* 6x	[36]
R7: *5 sc, inc* 6x	[42]
R8-13: 1 sc in each st (6 rounds)	[42]
R14: *5 sc, dec* 6x	[36]
R15: *4 sc, dec* 6x	[30]
R16: *3 sc, dec* 6x	[24]

Put fiber filling in the head and add while you work.

R17: *2 sc, dec* 6x R18: *1 sc, dec* 6x R19: *dec* 6x	[18]
	[12]
	[6]

Cut the yarn and pull it through the last 6 sts. Tighten and weave in ends.





Body

In white (001)

R1: 6 sc in a MR	[6]
R2: *inc* 6x	[12]
R3: *1 sc, inc* 6x	[18]
R4: *2 sc, inc* 6x	[24]
R5: *3 sc, inc* 6x	[30]
R6-9: 1 sc in each st (4 rounds)	[30]
R10: *3 sc, dec* 6x	[24]
R11-12: 1 sc in each st (2 rounds)	[24]
R13: *2 sc, dec* 6x	[18]

Put fiber filling in the body and weave in ends. Leave a long tail for sewing the head to the body.



Arm x2

Begin in Light Coral (050)

R1: 6 sc in a MR [6] R2: *1 sc, inc* 3x [9]

Switch to white.

R3-7: 1 sc in each st (5 rounds) [9]

Do NOT put fiber filling in the arms. Weave in ends and leave a long tail for sewing them to the body.

Sew the arms to the sides of the body over R10-12. See the picture.







Legs x2

Begin in Light Coral (050)

R1: 6 sc in a MR R2: *inc* 6x	[6] [12]
R3-8: 1 sc in each st (6 rounds)	[12]

Put fiber filling in the legs. Weave in by pulling the thread through the front loops of the last 6 sts. Tighten and weave in ends. Sew the legs to the sides of the body over R5-6. See the picture.

Ear x2

R9: *dec* 6x

R1: 4 sc in a MR	[4]
R2: *1 sc, inc* 2x	[6]
R3: *inc* 6x	[12]
R4-5: 1 sc in each st (2 rounds)	[12]
R6: *dec* 6x	[6]
R7: 1 sc in each st	[6]

Weave in and leave a tail. Do not fill the ears. Sew the ears to the head over R4-6. Sew on so they are slightly crooked.







Horn in white

R1: 4 sc in a MR	[4]
R2: *1 sc, inc* 2x	[6]
R3: *1 sc, inc* 3x	[9]
R4-6: 1 sc in each st (3 rounds)	[9]

Weave in ends and put a little filling in the horn. Attach the horn between the ears on the front of the head over R3-5.

Snout

In Old Rose (046)

R1: 6 sc in a MR R2: *inc* 6x R3: *1 sc, inc* 6x R4-5: 1 sc in each st (2 rounds)	[6] [12] [18] [18]
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Weave in ends and put filling in the snout. Attach the snout to the head over R8-14.

Mane

1x Light Coral (050) 1x Light Purple (040) 1x Delicate Light Blue (026)

Work 21 ch. Start in the second ch from the hook and work 3 sc in each st [60].

Attach the manes to the head around the horn.





Tail

1x Light Coral (050)

Work 16 ch. Start in the second ch from the hook and work 3 sc in each st [45].

Attach the tail to the back of the body over R3-4.





Embroider the eys in R10 over 3 sts. See the picture.

Embroider the nostrils to the snout. See the picture. And now the unicorn is ready!
