



# Douro Scarf

No. 2003-193-2982

## Materials:

Circular needle size 3 (3 mm), 31in (80 cm)

6 50g skeins of Highland Wool no. 34

## Tension:

25 stitches to 4 in

44 rows to 4 = every rib row the "V" is across 2 rows.

## Measurements:

Width approx. 10 in

Length approx. 71 in

## Pattern notes:

The scarf is knitted back and forth on circular needles.

### Edging stitches

The first 2 stitches of every row are edging stitches. You slip these purl wise with the yarn at the front of your work.

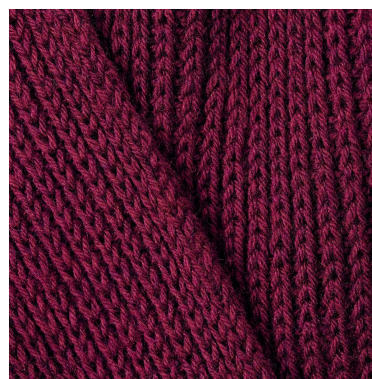
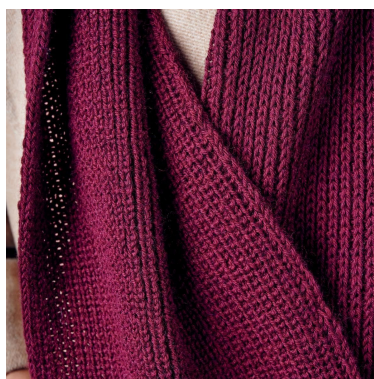
### Half a fisherman's rib stitch

The half a fisherman's rib stitch is made like this: \*purl 1, knit 1 into the stitch of the row below".

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## **SCARF**

Cast on 70 stitches and knit back and forth on the circular needle.

**Row 1:** 2 edging stitches, knit the remaining stitches.

**Row 2:** 2 edging stitches, half a fisherman's rib stitches until you have 2 stitches left, knit 2.

Repeat these 2 rows.

Knit until your work measures approx. 71 in.

Cast off in rib.
