# Materials:

1 (1) 2 (2) 2 skeins of 1.8 oz. (50 g) Alpaca Silk, col: 03, **A** 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 skeins of 1.8 oz. (50 g) Alpaca Silk, col: 17, **B** 

Circular needle 31.5 inches (80 cm), US size 4 (3,5 mm)

5 buttons

Sizes: 3-6 (6-9) 9-12 (12-18) 18-24 months

# Measurements:

Width: 9.8 (10.6) 11.4 (12.2) 13 inches (25 (27) 29 (31) 33 cm) Length: 11.4 (12.2) 13 (13.8) 14.6 inches (29 (31) 33 (35) 37 cm)

# Pattern information:

You don't knit edge stitches, but stockinette stitches over each stitch of the sweater. The edges are made by knitting garter stitches. The front bands are knitted in the end.

# Pattern

# Body

Cast on 120 (130) 140 (150) 160 sts in color **A** and knit back and forth on a circular needle. Knit 0.6 inches (1.5 cm) of garter stitches.

## Continue in stockinette stitches and stripes:

Knit \*2 rows in color **A** and 2 rows in color **B**\*, repeat from \*to\* until the work is finished.

Knit until your work measures 7 (7.5) 7.9 8.3 inches (18 (19) 20 (21) 22 cm). End with a right side row.

Place a marker in each side seam = 30(33)35(38)40 sts to the front pieces and 60(64)70(74)80 sts to the back.

**Next row**: Bind off 6 sts over each side seam = 27 (30) 32 (35) 37 sts on the front pieces and 54 (58) 64 (68) 74 sts to the back.

Remove the markers at the side seams.

Put the work on hold and knit both sleeves.

## Sleeves

Cast on 40 (42) 42 (44) 44 sts in color **A** and knit back and forth on a circular needle. knit 0.6 inches (1,5 cm) of garter stitches.

Continue in stockinette stitches and stripes, as you increase with 1 stitch in each side every 8th row until you have 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 sts.

Knit straight up until the sleeve measures 6.3 (7) 7.9 (8.7) 9.4 inches (16 (18) 20 (22) 24 cm). End with a right side row and with the same color as the body, so the stripes match.

**Next row:** bind off 3 sts, knit until you have 3 sts left, bind off 3 sts = 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts. Put the work on hold.

Knit one more sleeve in the same way.

## Yoke

From the right side, knit the sleeves and the cardigan together: knit 27 (30) 32 (35) 37 sts to the front piece, 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts to the sleeve, 54 (58) 64 (68) 74 sts to the back, 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts to the sleeve, 27 (30) 32 (35) 37 sts on the front piece = 196 (210) 224 (238) 252 sts.

Knit 1 row and place a marker where the cardigan is assembled = 4 marks.



## Start the raglan-decreases:

Knit until \*3 sts before the mark, 2 sts together knitwise, knit 2, 2 sts together through the back loops\*, repeat from \*to\* at each mark = 8 sts decreased.. Decrease every 2nd row 13 (14) 16 (17) 19 times = 92 (98) 96 (102) 100 sts. End with a purl row.

## Neckline

Bind off in the beginning of each row:

1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts (1 x 5 sts, 2 x 3 sts) 1 x 5 sts,

2 x 3 sts (1 x 5 sts, 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts) 1 x 5 sts, 1 x 4 sts,

1 x 3 sts, **WHILE** decreasing the ragian seams 3 times = 50(52)50(54)52 sts left on the row.

### Neckband

In color **A**, from the right side, knit up stitches on the front piece, knit the sts on the row, knit up sts on the front piece = approx. 68 (74) 72 (78) 76 sts. Knit 0.6 inches (1,5 cm) of garter stitches. Bind off.

### Left selvedge

In color **A**, from the right side, knit up sts along the front edge (selvedge) (skip every 4th row).

Knit 0.6 inches (1,5 cm) of garter stitches. Bind off.

Sew 5 buttons on the selvedge, evenly placed.

#### Right selvedge

Knit just like the left selvedge, but on the 2nd row, knit button holes opposed to the buttons, like this: \*knit to the button, bind off 1 stitch\*, repeat from \*to\* 5 times, knit the rest of the row.

Knit a total of 0.6 inches (1,5 cm) of garter stitches. Bind off.

#### **Finishing touch**

Sew the sleeve seams together. Sew it together under the sleeves.
