Brown Vintage: 10 g

Off-white Vintage: 5 g

MATERIALS

Embroidery yarn

Felt

Lace ribbon

Buttons

Toy stuffing

Safety pin

Metal wire

Eyes: 5 mm

Double pointed needles: 3,0 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.

Mounting of the safety eyes:

The eyes are inserted, and the rear stops to the eyes are pushed from the inside.
The rear stops can and should be a little hard to plug in to ensure that they are sticking well.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	stitch(es)
k	knit
p	purl
M1B	increase (lift the loop between the stitches from behind with the left needle. Work it as a knit stitch)
k 2 in same st	increase. Knit from the front and back in same stitch before it is taken off the needle
k2 tog	decrease. Knit 2 sts together
SSK	Slip, Slip, Knit. (decrease) Slip 2 stitches knit-wise one at a time. Insert left needle through front loop of both sts and k2 tog. Can be replaced by knitting 2 sts twisted together
Cord knitting	use two double-pointed needles. Instead of turning the work, push the work to the other end of the needle, tighten the yarn on the back and work the row again with knit stitches. Repeat. A cord will appear
* ... *	to end repeat what is shown in these brackets to the end of the row
(..)	at the end of the line, specifies the number of sts on the needle

ELLIE

BODY (BROWN)

Cast on 6 sts distributed on 3 double-pointed needles and work in the round (stocking stitch).

Thread the yarn through the stitches.

Put the fill in the body, pull together and fasten.

HEAD (BROWN)

Cast on 6 sts and work back and forth (stocking stitch).

Cut the yarn, thread the yarn through the stitches, tighten the yarn and sew the head together, leave a little opening. Stuff the head with toy stuffing.

Shape the head and eye sockets by drawing a thread from the head's opening (where it will be

sewn on the body) to the placement of one of the eyes, lead the thread around a stitch, and back again.

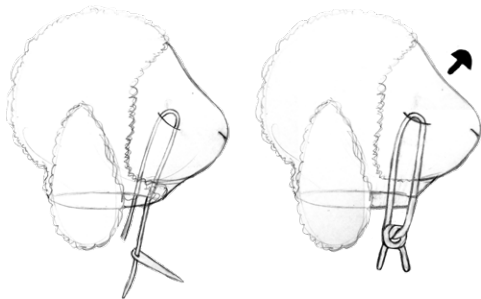
Tighten the thread to form an eye socket and fasten the threads by tying a knot. Repeat for the other eye. See illustration.

Attach the safety eyes.

Close the last opening.

Embroider a "Y" with black embroidery yarn as a snout, and embroider a small nose in coloured embroidery yarn between the "arms" of the Y.

Sew the head onto the body.



EAR (BROWN, 2 X)

Cast on 10 sts distributed on 3 double-pointed needles and work in the round (stocking stitch).

Thread the yarn through the stitches, pull together and fasten. Sew the ears onto the head.

ARM (BROWN, 2 X)

Cast on 4 sts.

1. - 10.) Cord knitting (4)

Thread the yarn through the stitches, pull together and fasten. Sew the arms onto the body.

LEG (BROWN, 2 X)

Cast on 5 sts.

1. - 8.) Cord knitting (5)

Thread the yarn through the stitches, pull together and fasten. Sew the legs onto the body.

DIAPER (OFF-WHITE)

Cast on 3 sts and work back and forth (stocking stitch).

1.) p (3)

2.) 1k, M1B, 1k, M1B, 1k (5)

3.) p (5)

4.) 1k, M1B, 3k, M1B, 1k (7)

5.) p (7)

6.) 1k, M1B, 5k, M1B, 1k (9)

Continue with increase on each side of every k-round until there are 25 sts in total.

Close it LOOSELY. Fasten the ends.

Hold the diaper together with a safety pin.

BLANKET (GREY)

Cast on 17 sts and work back and forth (knit).

1 - 3.) k (17)

4.) 2k, 13 p, 2k (17)

5. - 20.) Pattern (see diagram)

21.) k (17)

22.) 2k, 13 p, 2k (17)

23. - 25.) k (17)

Close off and fasten the ends.

STROLLER

Lay the pattern sheets on the felt and cut in accordance with the given pattern sheet.

The half circles are adapted with pins on each side of the oblong piece of felt. The sides are then sewn together with buttonhole stitches.

The buttons are sewn on as wheels, two on each side. They must be sewn on as close to the edge as possible.

The lace is then glued or stitched onto the top edge of the stroller.

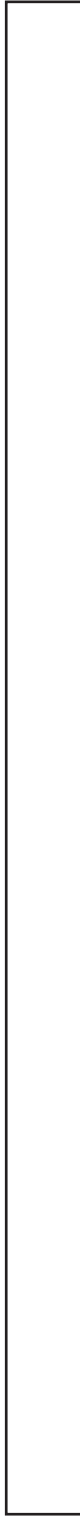
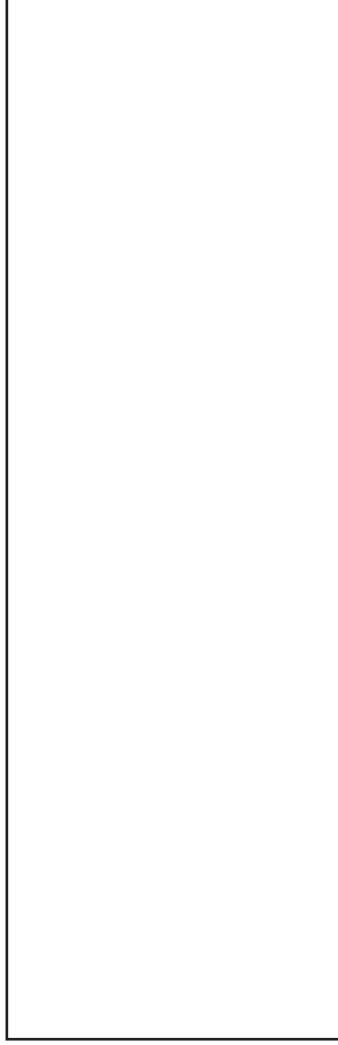
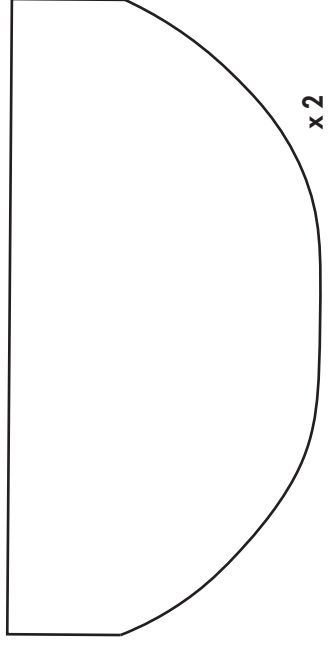
The felt strip is placed as the stroller's handle.

It is sewn on the inside with a whip stitch.

Good to know

Needle Size + Tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us.

The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles.

Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.



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
