

## Warm stripes - Blanket

## Materials:

Lollipop
Recommended crochet hook US size J/10-L/11 ( 7 mm )
Buy yarn and supplies here:
http://shop.hobbii.com/warm-stripes-blanket
Yarn consumption: approx.: 40.6 oz . ( 1150 g ) (6 skeins)

Measurements: approx. $51.2 \times 70.9$
inches ( $130 \times 180 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Gauge: approx.
10 stitches $=8$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{x}$
10 cm )

## Abbreviations:

s: stitch
ch: chain stitch
hdc: half double crochet stitch sc: single crochet


Pattern - Visual instructions are available at the end of the pattern.

## NOTE:

You turn by chaining 2 which replaces 1 hdc . Cast on your ch sts loosely or use a bigger hook to avoid a wavy cast on-edge.
Please be aware that the colors also change in the middle of a row.
Each skein starts and ends differently.
If you prefer, you can add a new skein, as an attempt to make the color transitions look soft. If you wish to do so, take a look at the various skeins and decide which skein fits the order of color best.

1. Ch 130. In the 4th ch from the hook work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc.
"Skip 1 ch stitch. Work 1 hdc ch 1 and 1 hdc in the next ch".
Repeat from "to" till the end of the row until you have 2 ch stitches left. Skip 1 ch stitch and work 1 hdc in the last s.
2. Turn by chaining 2 . "work 1 hdc , ch 1 and 1 hdc in the ch-space from the previous row". Repeat from "to" till the end of the row. Work 1 hdc in the last s.

Repeat the procedure described in row 2 until you have 150 rows in total.
Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

## Instructions:

The guide displays smaller stitches, but the procedure is the same.

## Row 1



1. Cast on your ch stitches.

2. In the 4 th ch stitch from the hook, work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc . The needle here marks the ch stitch into which you are going to crochet.

3. Like this.

4. Work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc in the next ch stitch.

5. Work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc in the next ch stitch.

6. Skip 1 ch stitch.

7. Skip 1 ch stitch.

8. "Skip 1 ch stitch.. Work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc in the next ch stitch. Repeat from "to" till the end of the row until you have 2 ch sts left.

9. Skip 1 ch stitch and work 1 hdcs in the last s.
10. That was row 1.

## Row 2 <br> Row 2



1. Turn your work by chaining 2 (replaces 1 hdc).


2. Like this.
3. "Work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc in the ch-space from the previous row". The needle here marks the ch-space into which you are going to crochet.

4. Like this.

5. Like this.

6. Work 1 hdc in the last s.

7. "Work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc in the next chspace"

8. Repeat from "to" till the end of the row.

9. Like this.

10. That was row 2.

## Row 3



1. Row 3 is worked as row 2 . Turn your work by chaining 2 (replaces 1 hdc).

2. Repeat from "to" till the end of the row.

3. "Work 1 hdc, ch 1 and 1 hdc in the first chspace from the previous row. The needle here marks where you should crochet.

4. Work 1 hdc in the last s.

5. Like this.

Row 4 and onwards

Repeat the procedure in row 2 until you have
150 rows of pattern in total. Cut the yarn and

6. That was row 3.


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
