



The Nile - Hat

Materials

3 (3, 4) skeins of 1.8 oz. (50 g) Starlight, color 20

Circular needle US size 7 (4,5 mm) pon 31.5 inches (80 cm) Cable needle Pom-pom maker, Clover 2.6 inches (65 mm)

Yarn qualities Starlight, Hobbii 60% wool SW, 25% polyamide, 15% reflective yarn / 1.8 oz. (50 g) = 69 yards (64 meter) When hit by light, the yarn reflects the light

Knitting gauge 24 stitches on 4" (10 cm) in cable pattern

Sizes S (M, L)

Measurements

Circumference: 19.7 (20.9, 22) inches (50 (53, 56) cm), the width will give

Pattern information

You knit a rib edge and then you knit cables. The hat is knitted in the round on a circular needle using the magic loop technique.

Make a pom-pom of yarn and sew it onto the top of the hat.

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Edge with cables



Decreases and pom-pom



Lights up in the dark, if struck by light due to reflective thread in the yarn

Happy knitting!



Pattern

Cast on 96 (104, 112) sts on a circular needle US size 7 (4,5 mm). Knit rib in the round: k 1, p1.

Knit until the edge measures 0.8 (1.2,1.6) inches (2 (3, 4) cm).

Increase on the next round in knit stitches like this:

knit 4, increase with 1 stitch by picking up the strand, and knitting it through the back loop, repeat from * to * 24 times in total, knit 0 (8, 16) sts = 120 (128, 136) sts.

Continue in pattern:

- **1. rnd:** *p 2, k 6* around.
- 2. and 3rd rnd: repeat round 1.
- **4. rnd, cable rnd:** *p 2, place 3 sts on the cable needle in front of the work, k 3, knit the 3 sts on the cable needle*, repeat from * to* around = 15 (16, 17) cables.
- 5. to 10th round: work as rnd 1.

Repeat the 4th to the 10th rnd = cables every 7th rnd.

Knit until you have 5 cables in height and your work measures approx. 5.9 (6.3, 6.7) inches (15 (16, 17) cm).

End with the 5th rnd of the pattern.

Start decreasing:

6. rnd: *purl 2 together, k 6*, repeat from * to * around =

105 (112, 119) sts.

7. rnd: knit as the sts show.

8. rnd: *p1, k2, k2 together, k2*, repeat from * to * around =

90 (96, 102) sts.

- **9. rnd:** knit as the sts show.
- **10. rnd- cable rnd:** *p1, place 3 sts on the cable needle in front of the work, k2, knit the 3 sts on the cable needle*, repeat from * to * around.
- **11.** rnd, *p1, k2, k 2 together, k1*, repeat from * to * around = 75 (80, 85) sts.
- **12. rnd:** knit as the sts show.
- **13. rnd:** *p1, k2, k 2 together*, repeat from * to * around =

60 (64, 68) sts.

- **14. rnd:** knit as the sts show.
- **15. rnd:** *p1, k1, k2 together*, repeat from * to * around =

45 (48, 51) sts.

- 16. rnd: knit as the sts show.
- **17. rnd:** *p 1, k 2 together*, repeat from * to * around = 30 (32, 34) sts.
- **18. rnd:** * k 2 together*, repeat from * to * around = 15 (16, 17) sts.

Fasten off and pull the end through the stitches, tighten and weave in the ends of the wrong side.

Make a pom-pom and sew it onto the top of the hat.
