YARN USAGE

Bastian H 55 cm

Fur Lux 350 g

Tencel (crochet with 4 threads) 100 g

Lady H 53 cm

Fur Lux 300 g

Tencel (crochet with 4 threads) 100 g

MATERIALER

Filling

Eyes: 16 mm

Nose: 16 mm

Crochet hook: 6,0 - 7,0 mm



Crocheted in Go handmade's Fur Lux:
100% Polyester, 50 g/27 m and in Go handmade's
Tencel: 40% Tencel/60% Bamboo, 50 g/210 m.

MATERIALS:

Filling
Eyes: 16 mm
Nose: 16 mm
Crochet hook: 6,0 - 7,0 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.

Mounting of the safety eyes and noses:

The eyes/noses are inserted, and the rear stops to the eyes/noses are pushed from the inside. The rear stops can and should be a little hard to plug in to ensure that they are sticking well.

Add filling to the head

Close the hole by pulling the remaining thread through the 5 sts with a needle. Fasten the yarn ends.

Shape the eye hollows:

With Fur Lux yarn, thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn

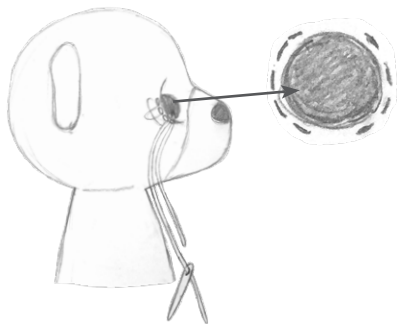
Put the needle in from the base of the head and out at the inner side of the eye.

Guide the thread across a couple of stitches by the eye and then back out at the base of the head.

Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye.

See illustration

To keep the pressure on the hollow, sew through a couple of sts at the base of the head.



Fasten the yarn ends.

Repeat for the other side of the same eye.

Should you want the hollow deeper the process may be repeated.

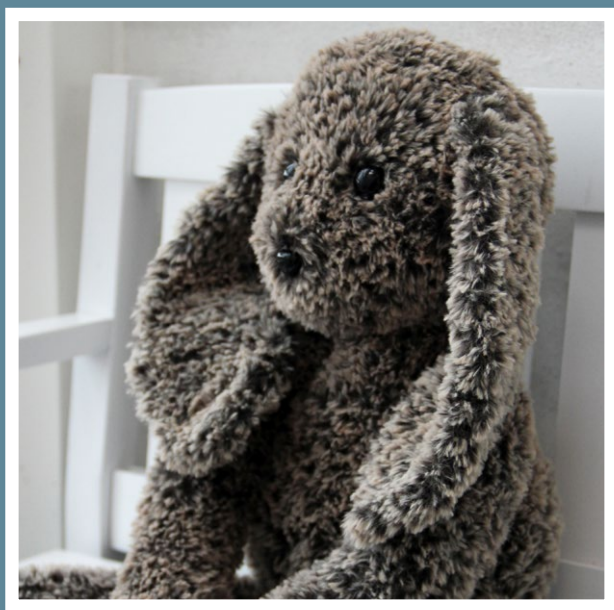

Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
