

## Bromus Hat

## Materials

Circular needle US size 2.5(3 mm) 31.5 inches ( 80 cm )

Circular needle US size 4 ( $3,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ ), 31.5 inches ( 80 cm )

If you like:
Double pointed needles US size 4 ( $3,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ )
1 skein of 1.8 oz. ( 50 g ) of Soft Alpaca col. 03 A (beige)
1 skein of 1.8 oz . 50 g ) of Soft Alpaca col. 06 B (dark gray)
1 skein of 1.8 oz. ( 50 g ) of Soft Alpaca col. 08 C (dark brown)

## Knitting gauge

24 stitches on 4" (10 cm)
28 rounds on 4 " ( 10 cm )

## Pattern information

The hat is knitted down-up on a circular needle using the magic loop technique.

It is up to you, if you prefer knitting with 2 or 3 colors when following the charts. If you only knit with 2 colors, you can embroider the 3rd color (dark brown) on the scarf in the end.

## Sizes

S (M) L

## Measurements

Fits head circumferences 21.3 (22) 22.8 inches (54 (56) 58 cm )


## Edge of hat

Cast on 116 (120) 124 sts in color B on a circular needle US size 2.5 ( 3 mm ).
Work 4 (4.3) 4.7 inches ( $10(11) 12 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) in the round in rib *knit 1, purl $1^{*}$.

## Hat

Switch to needle size $4(3,5 \mathrm{~mm})$ and knit 1 rnd of stockinette stitch in color B. Continue in the round following the chart.
The chart is repeated 4 times in the round and it is marked with 1 post in color $\mathbf{B}$ between each chart-repeat.

Size S: *knit 1 in color B, knit the chart* ${ }^{*}-4$ times in total
Size M: *knit 2 in color B, knit the chart* ${ }^{*} 4$ times in total.

Size L: *knit 3 in color B, knit the chart* - 4 times in total.

Knit until your work measures 5.9 inches ( 15 cm ) from the place where you changed the needle size.
Finish with 1 rnd in color $\mathbf{B}$.
Fasten off color $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{C}$ and continue in the round making decreases in color $\mathbf{B}$.

## Decreases

On the first rnd, decrease evenly until you have 112 sts in all sizes.
Place a marker after every 14th stitch from the beginning of the rnd = 8 markers.
Knit until you reach the marker, work 2 stitches together knitwise.
Decrease every $2 n d$ rnd by knitting until you reach the marker: work 2 sts together knitwise, 10 times in total $=32$ sts.
Knit the sts together 2 and $2=16$ sts.

Fasten off and pull the yarn tail through the stitches, tighten and weave in the end.
