



# The teasing elves Siv and Nælde

#### **Materials:**

Crochet hook US size H/8 (EU size: 5)

Hobbii Ribbon

Curly from Go Handmade

2 pairs of safety eyes 0.6 inches (16 mm)

8 wood beads 0.98 inches (25 mm)

Fiber fill

Sewing thread or embroidery thread for the mouth

**Yarn consumption:** – boy / girl

Red: approx. 5.6 oz. / 7 oz. (160g/200g)

Gray: approx. 1.4 oz. / 1.4 oz. (40g/40g)

Light beige: approx. 2.3 oz. / 2.3 oz. (65g/65g)

Curly: approx. 0.4 oz. (10g) for the girl Stuffing: approx. 3.5 oz. (100g) per elf

#### **Abbreviations:**

ch: chain stitch

mr: magic ring

**s**: stitch

**sc**: single crochet

dc: double crochet

ss: slip stitch

**blo:** Back loop only

#### **Measurements:**

approx. 13.8 inches (35 cm) tall from the tip of the hat to the

bottom



## Main pattern - used for both Siv and Nælde

## **Legs and arms:**

Work a foundation chain in red consisting of 40 ch. This is going to be legs.

Work a foundation chain in gray consisting of 40 ch. This is going to be the arms.

We'll get back to these parts when they are attached to the body later on.

## **Body:** In red

- 1. Work a mr, and crochet 6 sc into the ring (6)
- 2. Work 2 sc in each stitch around (12)
- 3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (18)
- 4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (24)
- 5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (30)
- 6. This round is worked in blo. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the nexts." Repeat "to" around (36)
- 7. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (42)
- 8. -11. Work sc around (42)
- 12. Switch to gray. Work sc in blo around (42)
- 13. -15. Work sc around (42)
- 16. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (36)
- 17. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (30)
- 18. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (24)
- 19. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (18)
- 20. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (15)

Don't fasten off, we are going to continue from here. Stuff the body with fiber fill.







## **Head:** Continue in light beige.

- 1. Work 2 sc in each stitch around (30)
- 2. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (36)
- 3. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (42)
- 4. Work "1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (48)
- 5. -8. Work sc around (48)
- 9. Work "1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (42)
- 10. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (36)
- 11. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (30)
- 12. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (24)
- 13. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (18) Insert the safety eyes between round 7-8 with an interspace of 2-3 sts. Start stuffing the head, and stuff it completely before the hole is crocheted shut.
- 14. Work "1 sc, 2 sc tog." Repeat "to" around (12)
- 15. Work 2 sc tog around (6)

## Sew the hole shut.



Now, insert the legs. Pull one end of the foundation chain out through round 6, and out again with an interspace of 6-7 sts. Place the beads on the chain and tie a knot in each end.







Now, pull the foundation chain (the arms) out through one side two rounds below the head, and out again on the other side.

Place the beads on the chain and tie a knot.



# Christmas hat: in red

- 1. Work a mr and work 6 sc into the ring (6)
- 2. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (9)
- 3. -4. Work sc around (9)
- 5. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (12)
- 6. -7. Work sc around (12)
- 8. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (15)
- 9. -10. Work sc around (15)
- 11. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (18)
- 12. -13. Work sc around (18)
- 14. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (21)



- 15. -16. Work sc around (21)
- 17. Work "1 sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next m." Repeat "to" around (24)
- 18. Work sc around (24)
- 19. Work "1 sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (27)
- 20. Work sc around (27)
- 21. Work "1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2 sc in the next." Repeat "to" around (30)
- 22. Work sc around (30)
- 23. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (36)
- 24. Work sc around (36)
- 25. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next s." Repeat "to" around (42)
- 26. Work sc around (42)
- 27. Work "1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc i next s." Repeat "to" around (48)
- 28. -31. Work sc around (48) The last round is finished with 1 ss.

Leave a long tail for sewing the christmas hat onto the head.



## Pattern - Nælde:

Follow the main pattern above regarding the arms, legs, body and head, and continue like this:

#### **Overalls:**

1. In red, insert the yarn into the sts from round 12 in front of the stomach where you would like to place the bib. This round is worked in the sts from round 12. Work 6 sc, ch 1, and work ss around, until you reach the start of the bib again, ch 1 and work 1 ss in the 1st sc.







- 2. Ch1, and work 1 sc into the 6 sts.
- 3. -4. Turn by chaining 1. Work 6 sc back again. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



Turn the elf around, and insert the yarn 18 sts from the bib in round 12. Ch 16 and pull the chain across the chest to the boy's shoulder.







Turn the elf around again, and ch 1 in the corner of the bib.

Work ch sts along the bib to the opposite corner.

Ch 16, and pull the chain across the elf's shoulder and over to the other side of the elf.



1 ss with an interspace of 2 sts from the other strap and weave in the end.





Sew the christmas hat onto the head.

Embroider the mouth and use a bit of blush to create cheeks.





**Pattern** – Siv:


Follow the main pattern above regarding the arms, legs, body and head, and continue like this:

## **Skirt:**

The skirt is crocheted in the round in the sts from round 12. Turn the elf around, so it faces you.

1. Insert the yarn in one of the sts, and work sc around and finish with 1 ss. (42)





2. Ch 2 (replaces 1 dc). Work dc around. Finish with 1 ss. (42)





3. Ch 2 (replaces 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same s. Work 1 dc in the next s. "Work 2 dc in the next s, 1 dc in the following s." Repeat from "to" around and finish with 1 ss. (63)



4. Ch 1. Work 2 sc in each s around. Finish with 1 ss. (126) Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

# **Hair**: In Curly



Cut 25 pieces of approx. 15.7 inches (40 cm) of Curly yarn.



Place it on top of the head.



Sew a few stitches in the middle across the hair.



Now, place the hat on the head and sew around the edge of the christmas hat.





If you like, you can make ponytails and trim the hair.

Embroider the mouth and use a bit of blush to create cheeks.





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
