



Rusty Gold Sweater

No. 1006-194-3682

Sizes: S, M, L, XL.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Crochet Hook: 5 mm (US size H)

Yarn: Diablo in Rust (16) and Mango (17)

How much yarn do you need?
S - 4 balls of Rust, 3 balls of Mango
M - 5 balls of Rust, 4 balls of Mango
L - 5 balls of Rust, 4 balls of Mango

XL - 5 balls of Rust, 4 balls of Mango

Abbreviations used in this pattern:

Ch - chain

Dc - double crochet Sc - single crochet Sl st - slip stitch St(s) - stitch (es)

Inc C- increase corners (1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc)
Inc F - Increase front panels (2 dc in the

same st)

Dec – decrease (dc2tog – 2 double

crochet worked together)

Sc2tog – 2 sc worked together

Gauge: 12 dc = 10 cm. 7 rows = 10 cm.


Design

This Rusty Gold Sweater is every crocheters dream! It's worked top-down using 2 strands of yarn. It has an oversized fit with a positive ease of 15 cm around the bust circumference. So If you love oversized mohair sweaters, this pattern is for you!

Pattern notes:

- The Ch 3 at the beginning of each round counts as the first dc.
- We are working in rounds and will be turning after each round.
- After finishing the V neck we will cut the yarn and start from the back, so the joining line won't be showing in the front.

Final measurements



Neck Line a: 22 cm (25, 28, 32) Bust Width b: 58 cm (63, 68, 73)

Underarm Length c: 36 cm (36, 36, 36)

Yoke Depth d: 26 cm (28, 30, 32) Length e: 53 cm (55, 56, 58)





Yoke

For the foundation chain you will use 2 strands, one of **Rust (16)** and one of **Mango (17)**. For each size you need to chain:

S - 62 sts

M - 68 sts

L - 72 sts

XL - 80 sts

Row 1

Ch 3 sts, starting with the 5th ch put 1 dc in each st to the end of the row. Ch 3 and turn.

Row 2

1 dc in the first st, 1 lnc C in next, 1 dc in next 15 (16, 16, 18) sts, 1 lnc C in next, 1 dc in next 26 (30, 34, 38) sts, 1 lnc C in next, 1 dc in next 15 (16, 16, 18) sts, 1 lnc C in next, 2 dc in the 3^{rd} st of the turning chain. Ch 3 and turn.



Row 3

1 dc in 1st st, [1 dc in each st until you reach the corner, 1 Inc C in the corner] Repeat to the end of the row. Finish the row, with 1 dc in next st and 2 dc in the 3rd st of the turning ch. Ch 3 and turn.

Next, repeat row 3 until you have the same number of sts in the front (counting both panels) as for the back. For each size you should have:

S – 13 rows

M – 15 rows

L – 17 rows

XL – 19 rows

Finish row 13 (15, 17, 19) by joining with a sl st in 3rd st of the turning chain. Cut the yarn and start the next row from the back.

For size XL, row 19 was the last row of the yoke. If you are working this size, just move forward to the Body part of the pattern.

For sizes S, M and L we will continue with the yoke a few more rounds, increasing in corners as we did before. We will start working in rounds, turning after each round. The ch 3 at the beginning of the round counts as first dc.

S – 3 more rounds

M - 2 more rounds

L - 1 more round

Body

On the first round of the body we will divide the yoke into sleeves and body. For all sizes:

Round 1

Put 1 dc in each st until you reach the 1st corner, 1 dc in the corner, ch 14, skip the sts for the sleeve, 1 dc in the next corner, 1 dc in each st until you reach the 3rd corner, 1 dc in the corner, ch 14, skip the sts for the sleeve, 1 dc in the 4th corner, 1 dc in each st to the end of the round. Ch 3 and turn.

Round 2

1 dc in each st around, including the underarm ch. Ch 3 and turn.



Round 3 - 4

Repeat round 2.

Rounds 5 - 11

Change color to 2 strands of Mango (17) and repeat round 2.

Rounds 12 - 21

Change color to 2 strands of Rust (16) and repeat round 2.

Rounds 22 - 23

Ch 1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next, [2 sctog, 1 sc in the next 2 sts] Repeat to the end of the round.

Round 24

Ch 1 and make 1 sc in each st around. Fasten off.

Sleeves

The sleeves are worked using the same color as the yoke, 1 strand of **Rust (16)** and one of **Mango (17)**.

Round 1

Start at the armpit, in the middle st of the underarm ch. Ch 3, 1 dc in each st around. Ch 3 and turn.

Round 2

Dc2 tog in the next 2 sts, 1 dc in each st, until you have 2 sts left, dc2tog in the last 2 sts. Join with a sl st in 1st st of the starting ch. Ch 3 and turn.

Rounds 3 - 6

Repeat round 2.

Rounds 7 - 24

1 dc in each st around.

Rounds 25 - 26

Ch 1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next, [2 sctog, 1 sc in the next 2 sts]. Repeat to the end of the round.

Round 27

Ch 1 and make 1 sc in each st around. Fasten off.



To finish: Weave in all ends and make 1 sc round, around the neck line in Mango (17).
