



Isla - Jacket

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Materials

1 (2, 2, 2,) skeins of Winter Glow col. 09 4 (4, 5, 5) skeins of Diablo col. 08

Circular needle US size 10 (6 mm) and 11 (8 mm) on 31.5 inches (80 cm) Open end zipper 19.7 inches (50 cm)

Yarn quality

Winter Glow, Hobbii 51% Wool, 49% Acrylic/ 7.1 oz. (200 g) = 765 yards (700 m) Diablo, Hobbii 30% Mohair, 30% Nylon, 40% Acrylic / 0.9 oz. (25 g) = 246 yards (225 meter)

Knitting gauge

13 stitches and 16 rows on 4 inches (10 cm) on knitting needle US size 11 (8 mm) and 2 threads

Sizes

S (M, L, XL)

Measurements

Half bust circumference: 18.5 (19.7, 20.9, 22) inches (47 (50, 53, 56) cm) Length: 27.6 (29.9, 32.3, 34.6) inches (70 (76, 82, 88) cm)

Pattern information

The jacket is knitted with 1 thread of each yarn quality = 2 threads in total. The jacket is knitted in one piece to the armhole. The front pieces and the back piece are knitted individually. The sleeves are knitted top down. The zipper is attached in the end by sewing. The length of the jacket will stretch since it is loosely knitted.

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Edge stitches on the front pieces

The first 3 stitches on the front pieces are edge stitches.

Slip 3 stitches loosely with the yarn in front of your work on the wrong side and with the yarn behind your work on the right side.

Body

Front pieces and back Rib edge

Cast on 148 (156, 164, 172) stitches on a circular needle US size 10 (6 mm) and knit 3.1 inches (8 cm) of rib *knit 1, purl 1*, back and forth on the circular needle. Switch to needle US size 11 (8 mm) and knit stockinette. Knit 7 inches (18 cm) straight up.

Place a marker in each side seam = 37 (39, 41, 43) stitches to the front piece, 74 (78, 82, 86) stitches to the back.

Start decreasing in the side seams.

Right side: Knit until 5 stitches before the marker, knit 2 together, knit 6, knit 2 stitches together through the back loops, knit until 2 stitches together through the back loops, knit until

3 stitches before the marker, knit 2 stitches together through the back loops, knit 6, knit 2 together, knit the rest of the needle =

4 decreases.

Decrease very 8th round until you have 31 (32, 33, 34) stitches on each front piece and 62 (64, 66, 68) on the back = 124 (128, 132, 136) stitches.

Knit straight up until your work measures 18.9 (20.9, 22.8, 24.8) inches (48 (53, 58, 63) cm). End with a right side round/row.

Divide for front pieces and back.

From the wrong side knit 29 (30, 31, 32) stitches, bind off 6 stitches, knit until you have 54 (56, 58, 60) stitches on the back, bind off 6 stitches, knit the rest of the needle = 29 (30, 31, 32) stitches.

Right front piece

Armhole

1. row, right side (RS): knit until you have 3 stitches left, knit 2 stitches together, knit 1.

- 2. row, wrong side (WS): purl.
- **3. row:** knit until you have 3 stitches left, knit 2 together, knit 1.
- 4. row: purl.

Now, you should have 27 (28, 29, 30) stitches.

Neckline

1. row, right side: slip the 3 edge stitches, knit 2 together, knit the rest of the needle.



2. row, wrong side: purl.

Repeat these two rows until you have 18 (19) 20 (21) stitches left on the needle. Knit straight up until armhole measures approx. 8.7 (9.1, 9.4, 9.8) inches (22 (23, 24, 25) cm). Put the stitches on hold.

Left front piece

Armhole

1. row, right side: knit 1, knit 2 together, knit the rest of the needle

2. row, wrong side: purl.

3. row: knit 1, knit 2 together, knit the rest of the needle.

4. row: purl.

Now, you should have 27 (28, 29, 30) stitches. Place the stitches on a stitch holder.

Neckline

1. row, right side: knit.

2. row, wrong side: slip the 3 edge stitches, purl 2 together, knit the rest of the row. Repeat these two rows until you have 18 (19, 20, 21) stitches left on the needle.

Knit straight up until armhole measures approx. 8.7 (9, 9.4, 9.8) inches (22 (23, 24, 25) cm.) Place the stitches on a stitch holder.

Back

Decrease for armhole at both sides on the back, like this:

1. row, right side: knit 1, knit 2 stitches together, knit the rest of the needle.

2. row: purl 1, purl 2 stitches together, purl the rest of the needle.

3. row: knit 1, knit 2 stitches together, knit the rest of the needle.

4. row: purl 1, purl 2 stitches together, purl the rest of the row.

Now, you should have 50 (52, 54, 56) stitches.

Knit straight up until armhole measures 7.1 (7.5, 7.9, 8.3) inches (18 (19, 20, 21) cm). Put the stitches on hold.

NOTE: The shoulder seam is placed 0.8 inches (2 cm) down the back.

Shoulder

Knit the right shoulder together with the back, like this:

Place the work together, right side facing right side, bind off using the 3-needle-bind-off technique.

Knit left shoulder together with the back the exact same way.

Place the remaining stitches on a stitch holder for the neck.

Neck

Bind off the stitches with an i-cord edge.

Place the neck stitches on a knitting needle, cast on 3 stitches using the knitted cast on technique, on the right side from the right side (RS).

Place the 3 new stitches on the needle, *knit 2, knit 2 stitches together through the back



loops, place the 3 stitches back on the needle*, repeat from * - * until all of the stitches have been bound off.

NOTE: Sew the edge of the neck together with the edge of the front piece using kitchener stitches.

Sleeves (knitted top down)

Knit up 58 (60, 62, 64) stitches in the armhole on a circular needle. Start at the bottom of the armhole.

Knit stockinette stitches using the magic loop technique on the circular needle. Place a marker mid under the sleeve.

Knit 4 rounds of stockinette stitches.

Start decreasing:

Decrease on each side of the marker, like this: knit until 2 stitches before the marker, knit 2 stitches together, knit 2 stitches together through the back loops.

Decrease every 6th round,10 times in total, until you have 38 (40) 42 (44) stitches. Knit until the sleeve measures approx. 17.7 inches (45 cm). On the next round decrease 4 stitches evenly = 34 (36) 38 (40) stitches.

Rib edge

Switch to circular knitting needle US size 10 (6 mm) and knit 1.6 inches (4 cm) of rib, knit 1, purl 1. Bind off loosely in rib.

Knit the other sleeve the same way.

Zipper

Attach the zipper using pins along the front edges, from the rib edge at the bottom to the decreases for the v-neck.

Sew on a sewing machine using long stitches.
