



Kawaii Watermelon - Rattle

No. 1011-194-2960

Level: Advanced

Size approx.: 15 x 7 cm

Crochet hook: 2,5 mm

Materials: Wooden ring 68 mm, pins, black embroidery thread, toy stuffing, sewing thread, sewing needle, safety eyes 7 mm, round rattle.

Abbreviations in this pattern:

m - stitch

ch - chain stitch

sc - single crochet

inc 1 st – work 2 sc in same stitch

dec 1 st – work 2 stitches together

sl st – slip stitch

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4.

How much yarn do you need?

Petunia Pink (87) - 1 ball

Dusty Lime (74) - 1 ball

Malachite Green (99) - 1 ball

White (01) - 1 ball

Pink (44) - 1 ball

Tip!

Use a stitch marker or safety pin to keep track of where the round begins. A wooden chopstick is perfect to use to get the piece thoroughly stuffed :-)

Watermelon

You begin at the bottom with *Malachite green yarn*.

Ch 14 and begin in 2nd ch from hook:

R 1: 12 sc, 3 sc in same st, 11 sc, inc 1 st (28),

R 2: inc 1 st, 11 sc, inc 1 st, 1 sc, inc 1 st, 11 sc, inc 1 st, 1 sc (32),

R 3: 1 sc, inc 1 st, 12 sc, inc 1 st, 2 sc, inc 1 st, 12 sc, inc 1 st, 1 sc (36),

R 4: 2 sc, inc 1 st, 13 sc, inc 1 st, 3 sc, inc 1 st, 13 sc, inc 1 st, 1 sc (40),

R 5: work 1 sc in each st (40).

Change to Dusty Lime.

R 6-7: work 1 sc in each st (2 omg, 40).

Change to White.

R 8: work 1 sc in each st (40).

Change to Petunia Pink.

R 9: work 1 sc in each st (40),

R 10: 2 sc, dec 1 st, 13 sc, dec 1 st, 3 sc, dec 1 st, 13 sc, dec 1 st, 1 sc (36),

R 11-13: work 1 sc in each st (3 omg., 36),

R 14: 2 sc, dec 1 st, 12 sc, dec 1 st, 2 sc, dec 1 st, 12 sc, dec 1 st (32),

R 15-16: work 1 sc in each st (2 omg, 32),

Embroider the mouth on to the watermelon and attach the safety eyes.

Embroider the mouth as a "V" in the middle of round 10. Attach the eyes in between round 11 and 12.

Embroider little cheeks on the outside of each eye (see photo).

R 17: dec 1 st, 1 sc, dec 1 st, 11 sc, dec 1 st, 1 sc, dec 1 st, 11 sc (28),

R 18-19: work 1 sc in each st (2 rounds, 28).

Stuff the watermelon as you go, and the hole is getting smaller. Don't forget to add the little round rattle.

R 20: dec 1 st, dec 1 st, 10 sc, dec 1 st, dec 1 st, 10 sc (24),

R 21-22: work 1 sc in each st (2 rounds, 24),

R 23: [2 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (18),

R 24: work 1 sc in each st (18),

R 25: [1 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (12),

R 26: [dec 1 st] x 6 (6),

Sew the hole together and bind off all ends.

Embroider little black seeds on top of the watermelon.

Piece for wooden ring

Work with Petunia Pink

Ch 25 and begin in 2nd ch from hook.

R 1–9: 24 sc (Work 9 rows back and forth, turn with ch 1).

Break yarn, but leave a long end for assembly.

Assembly

Fold the crocheted piece around the wooden ring and sew it together. You can see how to do this on the photos in the instruction below.

Fasten the watermelon on top of the ring using the pins and sew it thoroughly on to the ring.

Done! ☺
