



Winter Wind Scarf

Materials:

Magic Sock Wool color 11
Kid silk color 28
Recommended crochet hook US size 7
(4.5 mm)

Buy yarn and supplies here:

Yarn consumption approx.:

Magic Sock Wool 6.3 oz. (180 g) (2 skeins)
Kid silk 2.8 oz. (80g) (4 skeins)

Crochet gauge:

16 sts x 12 rows = 4 x 4 inches (10 x 10 cm) in
double yarn in pattern

Measurements: approx. 89.5 inches (227 cm)
long and 17.5 inches (44 cm) wide.

Abbreviations:

s: stitch

ch: chain stitch

hdc: half double crochet stitch

tog: together

Pattern – Instructions are available at the end of the pattern.

Note: This headband is crocheted using 1 thread of Magic Sock Wool and 1 thread of Kid Silk. Each row is turned by chaining 1. This ch stitch does not replace a stitch and is not included in the final stitch count.

1. Ch 3. Work 1 hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook. (2)
2. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (2)
3. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first s, 2 hdc in the last s. (3)
4. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (3)
5. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first 2 sts, 2 hdc in the last s. (4)
6. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (4)
7. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first 3 sts, 2 hdc in the last s. (5)
8. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (5)
9. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first 4 sts, 2 hdc in the last s. (6)
10. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (6)

Repeat this procedure until you have a total of 138 rows = 70 sts.

The scarf should not be any wider, and thus you start decreasing in every row.

139. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first 68 sts. Work the last 2 hdc tog. (69)

140. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (69)

141. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first 67 sts. Work the last 2 hdc tog. (68)

142. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in each s. (68)

Repeat this procedure until you have a total of 274 rows = 2 sts.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Instructions: (In the guide below we used a different type of yarn.)

Row 1



1. Ch 3.



2. Work 1 hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook. (2)

Row 2



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in each s. (2)

Row 3



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in the first s.



3. Work 2 hdc in the last s (3)

Row 4



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in each s. (3)

Row 5



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in the first 2 sts.



3. Work 2 hdc in the last s. (4)

Row 6



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in each s. (4)

Row 7 - 138



1. Repeat this procedure until you have a total of 138 rows = 70 sts.

The scarf should not be any wider, and thus you start decreasing in every row.

Row 139



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in the first 68 sts.



3. Work the last 2 hdc tog. (69)

Row 140



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in each s. (69)

Row 141



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in the first 67 sts.



3. Work the last 2 hdc tog. (68)

Row 142



1. Turn by chaining 1.



2. Work 1 hdc in each s. (68)

Row 143 - 274



- 1. Repeat this procedure until you have a total of 274 rows = 2 sts**

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
