



Power Stripes Pillow - Across

No. 1001-194-7595

Materials:

Woolpower, col. 9 and 25 Crochet hook 4.5 mm Inner pillow, 40 x 50 cm 3 buttons, 20 mm

Gauge: 15 sts x 11 rows = 10 x 10 cm **Yarn usage:** Color A: ~210g Color B: ~225g

Abbrevitations:

St(s): stitch(es) Ch: chain stitch Sc: single crochet Hdc: half double crochet

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Pattern instructions

- **1.** Using color A, ch 55. Hdc in 2nd st from the hook. Hdc in every st until end of row. (54 sts)
- **2.** Turn work and ch 1. Hdc until end of row. (54 sts)

Repeating the 2nd row, work stripes as described here:

5 rows color A (incl. The first 2 rows) 6 rows color B 4 rows color A 6 rows color B 10 rows color A 6 rows color B 4 rows color A 6 rows color B 7 rows color A

Now, the buttonholes are made. Continue in color A.

115. Turn work and ch 1. hdc in the first 12 sts. * ch 2, skip 2 sts, hdc in the next 12 sts *. Repeat between ** 3 times in all.

116. Turn work and ch 1. Hdc in every st, working 2 hdc in the ch-spaces. (54 sts)

117. Turn work and ch 1. Hdc in every st until end of row. (54 sts)

118. Turn work and ch 1. Sl st in ever st until end of row. (54 sts)

Cut the yarn and weave in ends.





Finishing:



1. Fold the work in the middle, where you have 10 rows of color A.



2. Fold the piece with buttonholes as shown here in the picture.





3. Work the edges in sc, catching both pieces to sew them together. Along the long edges.



4. Crochet through all 3 layers at the end.



5. Like so.



7. Sew on the 3 buttons so they match up with the buttonholes



6. Repeat on both sides. Cut yarn and weave in ends.



8. Put the inner pillow in the pillowcase and button it up.





9. Like this.
