



Cotton Stripes Cushion –Across

No. 1001-194-3347

Materials:

- Rainbow Cotton 8/8 – col. 14 and 79
- Recommended crochet hook US size C/2 or E/4 (3 mm or 3.5 mm)
- Cushion 15.7 x x19.7 inches (40x50 cm)
- 3 buttons: 0.8 inches (20 mm)

Crochet gauge: approx. 16 sts x 13.5 rows = 4 x 4 inches (10 x 10 cm)

Yarn consumption approx.:

Color A: 8.5 oz. (240g)

Color B: 7.4 oz. (210g)

Abbreviations:

s: stitch

ch: chain stitch

sc: single crochet stitch

hdc: half double crochet stitch

Pattern

1. In col. A. Ch 65. Work 1 hdc in the 2nd ch from the hook. Work hdc till the end of the row. (64)
2. Turn by chaining 1. Work hdc till the end of the row. (64)
Repeat row 2 and work stripes like this:

7 rows color A – Including the first 2 rows.

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

14 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

5 rows color A

7 rows color B

11 rows color A

Now, you are going to make buttons holes - Continue in color A.

143. Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 hdc in the first 14 sts. Ch 2, skip 2 sts and work 1 hdc in the next 15 sts. Ch 2, skip 2 sts and work 1 dc in the next 15 sts. Ch 2, skip 2 sts and work 1 dc in the last 14 sts.

144. Turn by chaining 1. Work hdc in each stitch. Work 2 hdc in each button hole. (64)

145. Turn by chaining 1. Work hdc till the end of the row. (64)

146. Turn by chaining 1. Work slip stitches till the end of the row. (64)

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



Assembly:



1. Fold the piece in the middle so you have 14 rows of color A.



2. Fold the piece with the button holes as shown in the picture above.



3. Now, crochet the two pieces together by crocheting sc along the long sides of the cushion.



4. Work through all 3 layers at the end of the cushion.



5. Like this.



6. Repeat on both sides. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



7. Sew the 3 buttons on to the cushion, so they fit the button holes.



8. Insert the cushion in the cover and button up the cushion.



9. Like this.
