



Solli Hat

Materials:

Baby Merino XL

Pom-pom 4.3 or 5.1 inches (11 or 13 cm) Recommended crochet hook US size: G/6 (4 mm)

Sizes: 19/19.7 (20.5/21.3) 22/22.8 inches (48/50 (52/54) 56/58 cm)

Height: approx. 9 (9.8) 10.6 inches (23 (25) 27 cm) without the folded edge

Yarn consumption: approx. 2.5 (3) 3.5 oz. (70

(85) 100g)

Crochet gauge: approx.

20 sts x 14 rows = 4 x 4 inches (10 x 10 cm) - It

will stretch

Abbreviations:

s: stitch

sts: stitchesch: chain stitch

sc: single crochet stitch

hdc: half double crochet stitch

ss: slip stitch

blo: back loop only



Info:

If you prefer the hat larger or smaller, you merely crochet more or fewer rows prior to assembly. You can adjust the height of the hat by crocheting more or fewer chain stitches from the beginning.

Pattern - Instructions are available at the end of the pattern

Note: Each row is turned by crocheting 1 or 2 chain stitches. These do not replace any stitches and are not included in the final stitch count.

From row 2 and onwards, all stitches are worked in the blo. However, the last stitch of each row is worked through both loops.

- **1.** Ch 50 (54) 58. Work 1 hdc in the first 40 (44) 48 ch stitches. The first hdc is worked in the 3rd ch from the hook. Work 1 sc in the last 8 ch stitches = 48 (52) 56 sts.
- 2. From now on, all stitches are worked in blo.

Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 sc in blo in the first 8 sts. Work 1 hdc in the blo in the last 40 (44) (46) 48 sts = 48 (52) 56 sts.

- 3. Turn by chaining 2. Work 1 hdc in blo in the first 40 (44) (46) 48 sts. Work 1 sc in blo in the last 8 sts = 48 (52) 56 sts.
- **4.** Turn by chaining 1. Work 1 sc in blo in the first 8 sts. Work 1 hdc in blo in the last 40 (44) (46) 48 sts = 48 (52) 56 sts.

Repeat row 3 and 4 until you have 46 (52) 56 rows in total.

Assembly – Instructions are available at the end of the pattern.

Ch 1. Fold the hat in the middle and work the sides together with ss. Cut the yarn and leave a long tail. Sew the hole shut in the top by basting with a needle and yarn around into the stitches, and tighten. Sew the hole completely shut. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Sew the button from the pom-pom on to the top of the hat, and attach the pom-pom to the top of the hat.



Instructions:

Row 1



1. Ch 50 (54) 58



2. Work 1 hdc in the first 40 (44) 48 ch stitches. The first hdc is worked in the 3rd ch from the hook.



3. Like this.



4. Work 1 sc in the last 8 ch stitches = 48 (52) 56 sts.



Row 2



5. From now on, all stitches are worked in blo.

Turn by chaining 1.



6. Work 1 sc in the blo of the first 8 sts. The needle marks the loop into which your sc should be worked.



7. Like this.



8. Work 1 hdc in blo in the last 40 (44) (46) 48 sts = 48 (52) 56 sts.



Row 3



9. Turn by chaining 2.



10. Work 1 hdc in blo in the first 40 (44) (46) 48 sts.



11. Work 1 sc in blo in the last 8 sts = 48 (52) 56 sts.

Row 4



12. Turn by chaining 1.



13. Work 1 sc in blo in the first 8 sts.





14. Work 1 hdc in blo in the last 40 (44) (46) 48 sts = 48 (52) 56 sts.

Row 5 and onwards



15. Repeat row 3 and 4 until you have 46 (52) 56 rows in total.



Instructions - Assembly:



1. Ch 1. Fold the hat in the middle



2. Crochet the sides together using ss.



3. Like this.



4. Cut the yarn and leave a long tail.



5. Sew the hole together in the top of the hat by basting with a needle and yarn around into the stitches.



6. Like this.





7. Tighten.



8. Sew the hole shut.



9. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
Sew the button from the pom-pom on to the top of the hat, and attach the pom-pom to the top of the hat.



10. Like this.



11. Fold the edge of the hat. Now, your hat is ready to be worn \bigcirc





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
