



Uma - Jacket

Materials

5 (6, 6) skeins of Woolpower Big color 25 4 (5, 5) skeins Woolpower Big color 21

Straight needles no. 13 (9 mm) and 15 (10 mm) Circular needles 32" (80 cm) no. 13 (9 mm) and 15 (10 mm)

Markers

Divisible zipper 50 (50) 60 cm

Yarn quality

Woolpower Big, Happy Sheep 100% wool, 3.5 oz (100 g) = 82 yds (75 meter)

Gauge

9 sts and 18 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Half Fisherman's rib on needle no. 15 (10 mm)

Size

S (M, L)

Measurements

Width: 17.3" (19½", 22") or 44 (50, 56) cm Length: 21¹/₄" (22", 22.8") or 54 (56, 58) cm

Pattern information

The jacket is knit in a Half Fisherman's rib pattern with one color for the body and a contrast color on both sleeves.

The body is knit in one piece to the armhole. Then the front pieces and the back is knit seperately with raglan decreases.

The sleeves are knit to the armhole and you decrease for raglan as on the jacket.

The sleeves are sewn on and then the collar is knitted.

The zipper is sewn in as the last thing

Pattern, Half Fisherman's rib Wrong side: Knit.

Right side: Alternately p1 and k1 in the st from previous row. With this the "knit stitch is long".

Increases and decreases are made on wrong side rows.

Fronts and back

Rib

Cast on 79 (91, 103) sts in color 25 on needle no. 13 (9 mm) and knit rib like this:

1st row, wrong side: p1, *k1, p1*, rep from * - * across.

2nd row, right side: k1, *p1, k1*, rep from * - * across.

Repeat these 2 rows to the rib measures approx. 3.1" (8 cm). Finish with a right side row.

Body

Switch to needle no. 15 (10 mm).

Continue in Half a Fisherman's rib with 3 sts in rib on each front band.

NB On every 8th row, do not knit the band on both sides – like this:

Knit to 3 sts left, turn using German Short Rows, knit to 3 edge sts left, turn using German Short Rows. On next row the turn st is knit as 1 st.

1st row, wrong side: p1, k1, p1, knit to 3 sts left, p1, k1, p1

NB It's important that you have k over k/p over p (on all even rows).

2nd row, right side: k1, p1, k1, p1, *k1 in the st from previous row, p1*, rep from * - * to 3 sts left, k1, p1, k1.

Rep these 2 rows to the work measures 13.4" (34 cm). Finish on a right side row.

Place a marker in each side seam: 20 (23, 26) sts to front, 39 (45, 51) sts for the back, 20 (23, 26) sts for front.

Armhole

Knit 18 (21, 24) sts on the front, bind off 4 sts for arm hole, k to 35 (41, 47) sts on the back, bind off 4 sts for arm hole, k across = 18 (21, 24) sts on front.

Raglan decreases

Right front piece

Work the first 18 (21, 24) sts. Place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.

RS: K1, p1, k1, p1, work half fisherman's rib until the armhole.

WS: P1, k2tog tbl, k until 3 sts remain, p1, k1,

p1.

Repeat these two rows, until a total of 5 decreases have been made = 13 (16, 19) sts for the front piece.

Now only decrease on every 4th row a total of 4 times = 9 (12, 15) sts.

Sizes M and L: Now only decrease on every other row a total of - (3, 6) times = - (9, 9) sts.

Neckline:

Place the 3 edge sts on a stitch holder and work the remaining 6 sts.

Continue working raglan decreases.on every other row and bo 1 st at the neckline side every other row, until 3 sts remain. K3tog= 1 st.

Place the st on a stitch holder.



Back piece

Work the 35 (41, 47) sts of the back piece.

RS: K1, work half fisherman's rib until 1 st before the armhole, k1.

WS: P1, k2tog tbl, k until 3 sts remain, k2tog, p1.

Repeat these two rows, until a total of 5 decreases have been made = 25 (31, 37) sts.

Now only decrease on every 4th row a total of 4 (5, 6) times = 17 (21, 25) sts.

Then decrease on every other row a total of 2 (3, 4) times = 13 (15, 17) sts.

Work 1 RS row.

Place the sts on a stitch holder.

Left front piece

RS: K1, work half fisherman's rib until 3 sts remain, k1, p1, k1.

WS: P1, k1, p1, k until 3 sts remain, k2tog, p1.

Repeat these two rows, until a total of 5 decreases have been made = 13 (16, 19) sts.

Now only decrease on every 4th row a total of 4 times = 9 (12, 15) sts.

Sizes M and L: Now only decrease on every other row a total of -(3, 6) times = -(9, 9) sts.

Neckline

All sizes

Place the 3 edge sts on a stitch holder and knit over the remaining sts.

Continue with raglan-decreases on every other row and bind off 1 st in the neck side on every other row until you have 1 st left.

Sleeves

Rib

Cast on 25 (27, 29) sts in color no. 21 on needle no. 13 (9 mm) and knit rib, like this:

1st row, wrong side: p1, *k1, p1*, rep from * - * across.

2nd row, right side: k1, *p1, k1*, rep from * - * across.

Rep these 2 rows 'til the rib measures approx. 3.1" (8 cm). Finish with a right side row.

Sleeve

Switch to needle no. 15 (10 mm) and knit Half a Fisherman's rib.

NB Make sure that you knit over knit and purl over purl.

Wrong side: p1, k to 1 st left, p1.

Right side: k1, Half a Fisherman's rib to 1 st left, k1.

Start increases

Wrong side: p1, yo, k to 1 st left, yo, p1.

Right side: k1, k the yo tbl (k or p according to what the sts show), knit Half a Fisherman's rib to the yo, knit the yo tbl (k or p according to what the sts show), k1 = inc 2 sts = 27 (29, 31) sts.

Increase on every 16th row, all in all 4 times = 33 (35, 37) sts.



Knit straight up 'til the work measures approx. 18.11" (46 cm). Finish with a right side row.

Armhole

Bind off 2 sts in the beginning of the next 2 rows = 29 (31, 33) sts.

Raglan decreases

Decrease for raglan as on the back (on the wrong side row).

Decrease 3 (3, 3) times on every other row,

Then 4 (6, 8) times on every 4th row and at last on every other row 'til there's 7 sts.

Place the sts on a stitch holder.

Knit the other sleeve just the same.

Assembling

Sew up the raglan seams.

Sew up the sleeves.

Sew up the armholes.

Collar

Set the 3 sts from the fronts on needle no. 13 (9 mm), knit up approx. 4 sts in the neckline, knit the sleeves and the back, knit up approx. 4 sts in the neckline and knit the 3 sts in the front = 43 (45, 47) sts.

Work in rib like this: *K1, p1*, until the work measures approx 3.9"-3.1" (10-8 cm). Bo loosely in rib.

Assembling

Sew a row of chain sts along the outer edge on the front so you get a more sturdy edge to sew the zipper on to.

Sew in the zipper so it fits by the cast on edge.
