



## Romantic - Crocheted Kitchen Towel

No. 1001-201-1935

**Materials:**

Hobbii Rainbow Bamboo  
Crochet hook 3,5 mm

**Tension:** Ca. 21 m x 11 rows = 10 x 10cm

**Amount of yarn needed:** Ca. 105g

**Measurement:** Ca. 42x 35 cm  
incl. edging

**Abbreviation:**

**ch:** chain

**st:** stitch

**sc:** single crochet

**dc:** double crochet

**Pattern** – Picture guide found at the bottom of the pattern.

**NB:** When turning your work, ch3. This will replace 1 dc.

1. Ch71, 1 dc in the 4th ch from the hook, 1 dc in each st. (69)
2. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st. (69)
3. Turn, ch3, [Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st. Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] to the end of the row.
4. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in the first st. [Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the ch-sp. Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] until there are 3 st left, 1 dc in the last ch-sp, skip 1 st, 2 dc in the last st.
5. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st and ch-sp. (69)
6. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st. (69)
7. Turn, ch3, [Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st, skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] to the end of the row.
8. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in the first st. [Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the ch-sp, skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] until there are 3 st left, 1 dc in the last ch-sp, skip 1 st, 2 dc in the last st.
9. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st and ch-sp. (69)
10. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st. (69)
11. Turn, ch3, [Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st, skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] to the end of the row.
12. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in the first st. [Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the ch-sp, skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] until there are 3 st left, 1 dc in the last ch-sp, skip 1 st, 2 dc in the last st.
13. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st and ch-sp. (69)
14. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st. (69)

15. Turn, ch3 [Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st, skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] to the end of the row.
16. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in the first st. [Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the ch-sp, skip 1 st, 1 dc, 1 ch and 1 dc in the next st]. Repeat [ to ] until there is 3 st left, 1 dc in the last ch-sp, skip 1 st, 1 dc in the last st.
17. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st and ch-sp. (69)
- 18.- 42. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st. (69)
43. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in the first 32 st, ch 5, skip 5 st, 1 dc in the last 32 st.
44. Turn, ch3, 1 dc in each st, 5 dc in the last 5 ch.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

**Edging:**

1 sc all the way around the dishcloth. 3 sc in the corners. Finish off the round with 1 sl st.

Ch1, 1 sc in each st. 3 sc in the corners. Finish the round with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



### Guidelines:

The guide is made with smaller stitches, but the method is the same.

#### Row 1



1. Ch71.



2. 1 dc in the 4th ch from the hook.



3. Like this.



4. 1 dc in each st. (69)

#### Row 2



5. Turn, ch3.



6. 1 dc in the next st.



7. Like this.



8. 1 dc in each st. (69)

### Row 3



9. Turn, ch3.



10. Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st.



11. Like this.



12. Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st.



13. Like this.



14. Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st.



15. Like this.



16. Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st.



17. Like this.



18. Repeat steps 10-12 to the end of the row.

## Row 4



19. Turn, ch1.



20. 1 dc in the first st.



21. Like this.



22. Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st.



23. Like this.



24. Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st,



25. Like this.



26. Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the ch-sp.



27. Like this.



28. Skip 1 st, 1 dc, ch1 and 1 dc in the next st.



29. Like this.



30. Repeat steps 26-28 until there are 3 st left.



31. 1 dc in the last ch-sp.



32. Like this.



33. Skip 1 st, 1 dc in the last st.



34. Like this.

## Row 5



35. Turn, ch3.



36. 1 dc in each st and ch-sp throughout the row.  
(69)

## Row 6



37. Turn, ch3.



38. 1 dc until the end of the row. (69)

## Row 7 to 44



39. Repeat the described pattern from above.
