## Materials:

Sultan Deluxe col. 31 or 20
Rainbow Cotton 8/4 col. 001
Crochet hook 2,5 mm and 3 mm

## Needed ca.:

1 skein Sultan Deluxe
50 g Rainbow Cotton 8/4
Buy yarn and accessories here:

Measurement: Ca. 70x70 cm incl. edging
Tension: Ca. $9 \times 9$ squares $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Abbreviations:

st: Stitch
ch: Chain
sc: Single Crochet
dc: Double Crochet
sl st: Slip Stitch

About the pattern "C2C" - corner to corner is crocheted in chains, double crochets and slip stitches. As the name implies, the pattern is crocheted from one corner to the next. "C2C" consists of small "squares" that come from a new square on each crocheted row, so they are constantly increased. The same is valid when we decrease, where there will be 1 "square" less for each row that is crocheted.

Pattern/Instructions: - Crochet with Sultan Deluxe with a size 3 hook

## Increase

1. Make 6 ch. In the 4th ch from the hook crochet 1 dc. Crochet 1 dc in the next 2 ch. You have now made 1 "square".

2. Turn and make 6 ch. In the 4 th ch from the hook, crochet 1 dc . Crochet 1 dc in the next 2 ch . Make 1 sl st in the left corner of the first "square" on the first row. Now you have made 1 "square".



Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc ). Crochet 3 dc in the same space that you have just made with your sl st and 3 ch. You have now made another 1 "square" and there are 2 squares in your row.

3. Turn your work with 6 ch . In the $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{ch}$ from the hook crochet 1 dc . Crochet 1 dc in the next 2 ch.

Make 1 sl st in the left corner of the $1^{\text {st }}$ "square" on the previous row. You have now made 1 "square".



Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc ). Crochet 3 dc in the same space you just made with the sl st and 3 ch . Make 1 sl st in the left corner of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ "square" of the previous row. You have now made another "square" and there are now 2 "squares" on your row.


Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc ). Crochet 3 dc in the same space that you have just made with the sl st and 3 ch. You have now made 1 "square" and there is now 3 "squares" on your row.


Repeat the rows until you have 59 squares or used half of your yarn.

## Decrease

Now that the wrap is at the right breadth, we will decrease on both sides to make it an even square.

1. Turn your work. Sl st along the side of the first "square". Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc ). Crochet 3 dc. Make 1 sl st in the upper corner of the "square" next to it.


Now crochet the row as normal until you reach the last "square".


When you reach the last "square" of the row, finish as such:
Make 1 sl st in the upper corner of the previous "square". There is now 1 "square" less on the row.

2. Turn your work. Crochet sl st along the side of the first "square". Make 3 ch (replaces 1 dc ). Crochet 3 dc . Make 1 sl st in the upper corner of the "square" next to it.



Now crochet the row as normal until you reach the last "square".


When you reach the last "square" on this row, finish as such:
Make 1 sl st in the upper corner of the "square" before. Now there is 1 "square" less on the row.


Repeat decreasing the rows until you have 1 "square" left. Turn your work and make sl st along the last square up to the corner. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.


## Edging- made in Rainbow Cotton 8/4.

Crochet with hook size 3 in the first round. From the $2^{\text {nd }}$ round change to hook size 2.5.

## Round 1



1. Insert the yarn 2 squares from a corner.

Insert the yarn between 2 squares. Make 2 ch.

3. Like this.

2. Crochet 1 sc in between the next 2 squares. The hook above shows where to crochet the sc.

4. Make 2ch.

5. Crochet 1 sc in the corner

7. Make 2 ch ..

9. Like this.

6. Like this.

8. Crochet 1 sc in the corner again.

10. Make 2 ch .

11. Crochet 1 sc in between the next 2 squares.

13. Make 2 ch.

15. Like this.

12. Like this.

14. Crochet 1 sc between the next 2 squares.

16. Repeat this the way around. Finish with 1 sl st in the first ch-sp you made.

17. Make 3 ch . These replace 1 dc .

19. Crochet 3 dc in the next ch-sp.

21. Crochet 5 dc in the ch-sp in the corner.

18. Crochet 2 dc in the ch-sp.

20. Like this.

22. Like this.

23. Crochet 3 dc in the next ch-sp.
25. Repeat this for the whole round and finish
with 1 sl st i the 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round.

24. Like this.


## Round 3


26. Make 3 ch . These replace 1 dc .

28. Crochet 3 dc .

30. Repeat this for the whole round and finish with 1 sl st in the 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round.

27. Crochet 1 dc in every st until the 3 rd st in the corner.

29. Crochet 1 dc in all st up to the next corner.

## Round 4


31. Make 1 ch . Crochet sc in all st of the round.

32. Finish with 1 sl st in the first sc.
