



Amethyst - Hat

Materials

1 (2, 2) skeins of Baby Merino col. 39 1 (1, 1) skein of Universe col. 18

Double-pointed needles and possibly a circular needle 31.5 inches (80 cm) / US size 6 (4 mm)
Stitch markers

Yarn quality

Baby Merino, Hobbii

100% SW Merino wool/ 1.8 oz. (50 g) = 180,4 yards (165 m)

Universe, Hobbii

98% acrylic, 2% polyester / 3.5 oz. (100 g) = 505 yards (462 m)

Knitting gauge

24 stitches on 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitches

Sizes

S (M, L)

Measurements

Circumference: 18.1 (18.9, 19.7) inches (46 (48, 50) cm), measured slightly stretched: it'll expand in its

width.

Length approx.: 9.4 (9.4, 9.4) inches

(24 (24, 24) cm).

Pattern information

The hat is knitted with 1 thread of Universe and 1 thread of Baby Merino = 2 threads.

Start witht the top and knit a small square. From here on, increases are made in each corner in stockinette stitches. From here on you continue in rib.

Pattern

The hat is knitted top-down.

The top

Cast on 7 stitches with 1 thread of each quality and knit using 2 double-pointed needles. Start with a row of purl stitches and knit 10 rows of stockinette stitches. Continue knitting in the round using 5 double-pointed needles and knit up stitches along the 3 sides like this:

Knit up 7 stitches along the left side of the work, 7 stitches along the cast-on-edge and 7 stitches along the right side = 4×7 stitches = 28 stitches.

- **1. round:** *cast on, knit 1, yarn over, knit 6*, repeat from * to * around = 8 yarn overs = 8 increases = 36 stitches.
- 2. round:knit, all yarn-overs are knitted through the back loops
- **3. round:** *knit 1, yarn over, knit 1, yarn over, knit 7*, repeat from * to * around = 8 increases = 44 stitches.
- **4. round:** knit, all yarn-overs are knitted through the back loops.

Place a marker **around** the stitch between the yarn overs / the increases = 4 markers. Continue working yarn-overs on each side of the marked stitch every 2nd round and knit the yarn-overs through the back loops.

Switch to a circular needle and knit in the round using the magic loop technique.

Continue working increases until you have 6.7 (7.1,7.5) inches (17 (18, 19) cm) in diameter.

The hat

Continue in rib: knit 1, purl 1.

Knit straight up until the rib measures approx. 7.9 inches (20 cm).

Bind off loosely in rib (possibly using needle US size 10 (6 mm).
