Materials

9 (10) 11 balls of Friends Kid Silk color 13, Ochre

Circular needle 31,5" (80 cm) / US 13 (9

70 % kid mohair, 30 % silk / 0.9 oz (25 g)

Jumper needles and double pointed

needles US 13 (9 mm)

2 stitch holders

Yarn properties

Kid Silk, Hobbii

= 213 yds (195 m)

Size S (M) L

Finished size

Width: 21.7" (23.6") 25.6" Length: 19.3" (19.7") 20.1"

About the pattern

The sweater is knit with 4 strands of Kid Silk. Knit from both ends of the ball at the same time. The sweater is knit bottom up. Armholes and neckline are bound off. The shoulders are stitched together and stitches are picked up in the armhole. The sleeves are knit top down.

Increasing by 1 stitch (inc1): Pick up the loop between the stitches and knit it through the back loop (tbl)

Turn stitch (turn st): Turn with the technique German short rows:

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Gauge

with four strands on needle US 13 (9 mm) 12 sts x 16 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Body

Co 121 (132) 143 sts on circular needle US 13 (9 mm) / 31,5" (80 cm) and knit 1 rnd of st st in the round.

Rnd with incs

k11, inc1, repeat throughout the rnd = 132 (144) 156 sts.

Knit st st in the round until the work measures 11.8".

Place a marker on each side = side seams = 66 (72) 78 sts for the back and front respectively.

Here the work is divided into armholes. Put the front sts on hold on the circular needle and knit the back on jumper needles.

Back

Knit st st in the flat on jumper needles. Work straight until the armhole measures 7.8" (8.3" 8.7"). End with a WS row.

Right shoulder (when wearing the sweater)

Shaping the shoulder with short rows:

k 27 (30) 33 sts, turn, 1 turn st,

*p until 7 sts remain at the shoulder, turn,

1 turn st, k until 3 sts remain at the neckline, turn,

1 turn st, p until 15 sts remain at the shoulder, turn,

1 turn st, k until 6 sts remain at the neckline, turn,

1 turn st, p throughout the row. Knit the turn sts as 1 st. Turn.

Bo these 27 (30) 33 sts. Knit the turn sts as 1 st.*

Place a marker 21 (24) 27 sts from each side. These sts are for the shoulder. The 6 sts are for the neck.

Neck

Place 12 sts on a stitch holder and finish the row.

Left shoulder

Follow the same procedure as for the right shoulder from * to *.

Place a marker 21 (24) 27 sts from each side. These sts are for the shoulder. The 6 sts are for the neck.



Front

Work straight in st st until the armhole measures 3.9". End with a WS row.

k 25 (28) 31 sts, place 16 sts on a stitch holder for the neck, k throughout the row.

The right and left side of the front are now knit separately.

Right side of the front (when wearing the sweater)

Dec at the neck like this:

Row 1: p throughout the row

Row 2: k2tog tbl, k throughout the row.

Repeat these two rows until 4 decs have been made = 21 (24) 27 sts remain for the shoulder.

Work straight until the armhole measures 7.5" (7.9") 8.3". End with a WS row. Bo.

Left side of the front (when wearing the sweater)

Dec at the neck like this:

Row 1: p throughout the row

Row 2: k until 2 sts remain, k2tog.

Repeat these two rows until 4 decs have been made = 21 (24) 27 sts.remain.

Work straight until the armhole measures 7.5" (7.9") 8.3". End with a WS row. Bo.

Sew the shoulder seams together.

Sleeves (knit top-down)

Pick up approx. 46 (48) 50 sts in the armhole on double pointed needles. The first rnd is k tbl. Place a stitch marker at the beg of the rnd.

Knit st st and k2tog on each side of the marker with a margin of 2 sts.

Dec every 2.0". Work straight until the work measures 15.7".

Evenly distributed over the next rnd, dec by 6 sts.

Bo.

Same procedure for the second sleeve.

Neckline

With a circular needle, pick up sts in the neckline and knit the sts placed on the stitch holders.

Bo on the RS.
