



Kawaii Bunny - Rattle

Skill level: Intermediate

Measurement: ca. 16.5 x 7 cm Crochet hook: 2.5 mm and 2.0 mm Material: Wooden ring 68 mm, pins, black embroidery yarn, filling, round

rattle for the bunny head, sewing thread, sewing needle

Abbreviations:

st: stitch ch: chain

sc: single crochet

inc: crochet 2 st in the same st
dec: crochet 2 st together

sl st: slip stitch dc: double crochet Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4

Yarn used:

White (01) - 1 skein

Light Purple (40) - 1 skein

Pink (44) - 1 skein Pink (45) - 1 skein

Pastel mint (25) - 1 skein Peach (49) - 1 skein Lime (18) - 1 skein

Tip!

Use a stitch marker or a safety pin to keep a track of where the round starts. A wooden chopstick is perfect for filling the bunny head with stuffing, so it is tightly stuffed.

Bunny head

With white yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Start by making a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring

Round 2: [inc] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, inc] x6 (18)

Round 4: [2 sc, inc] x6 (24)

Round 5: [3 sc, inc] x6 (30)

Round 6: [4 sc, inc] x6 (36)

Round 7: [5 sc, inc] x6 (42)

Round 8: [6 sc, inc] x6 (48)

Round 9-16: 48 sc (8 rounds, 48)

Round 17: [6 sc, dec] x6 (42)

Round 18: [5 sc, dec] x6 (36)

Stuff the head and keep stuffing as you continue and the hole gets smaller. Do not forget to place the rattle in the head.

Round 19: [4 sc, dec] x6 (30)

Round 20: [3 sc, dec] x6 (24)

Round 21: [2 sc, dec] x6 (18)

Round 22: [1 sc, dec] x6 (12)

Round 23: [dec] x6 (6)

Sew the hole shut and weave in the ends.

Bunny ears (make 2 pcs)

With white yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Start by making a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring

Round 2: [inc] x6 (12)

Round 3-11: 12 sc (12)

Cut the yarn off, leaving a 20 cm long thread to attach the ears with. Sew the ears on.



Eyes (make 2)

With white yarn and a 2 mm crochet hook

Start by making a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring Round 2: [inc] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, inc] x6 (18)

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Embroide eyelashes with black embroidery yarn.

Use pins to place the eyes and sew them on with sewing thread.

Nose

With pink yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Make a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Cut the yarn and sew the nose on

Embroider a mouth with black embroidery yarn

Cheeks (make 2 pcs)

With pink yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Make a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Cut the yarn and sew the cheeks on.

Carrot

With peach yarn and a 2.5mm crochet hook

Make a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring

Round 2: 6 sc (6)

Round 3: [1 sc, inc] x3 (9)

Round 4–6: 9 sc (9)

Round 7: In the back loops only, [1 sc, dec] x3 (6)

Carrot leaf

With lime yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Make a magic ring, don't close it too tightly

crochet 3 ch, 1 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 1 sc, 1 sl st in the ring Repeat this 5 times.

Leave a 20 cm long thread.

Sew the leaf onto the carrot.



Lace collar

With pastel mint yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Make a magic ring

Round 1: 3 ch, 11 dc in the ring, finish the round with 1 sl st. (12)

Round 2: 3 ch, 1 dc in the first st, 2 dc in every st of the round (24)

Round 3: 3 ch, 2 dc in the first st, 3 dc in every st of the round.

Cut the yarn.

Strap for the wooden ring

With light purple yarn and 2.5 mm crochet needle

Make 25 ch, start in the 2nd ch from the hook.

Rounds 1–9: 24 sc (crochet back and forth, 9 rounds in total, turn with 1 ch)

Cut the yarn and leave a long thread for assembly.

Assembly

Sew the carrot on to the bunny head. Sew the lace collar on under the bunny head. Place the crocheted strap along the wooden ring, lengthwise, and sew it shut around the ring. See the picture guide below this pattern.

Place the bunny on top of the rattle and sew it on well.
