Abbreviations:

st - stitch
ch - chain
hdc - half double crochet
dc - double crochet
trc - treble crochet
tch - turning chain
tog - together

Yarn: Sultan Deluxe

Yarn needed: French Blue (23) - 1 skein

Magical ring -

Pattern

Make a magic ring, but do not close it completely.

Round 1: Ch 4, 4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc, 1 trc in the ring, ch 4 and turn

Round 2: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc in the next 4 st, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, 1 dc in the next 4 st, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Round 3: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc in the next 8 st, [2dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, 1 dc in the next 8 st, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Round 4: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc in the next 12 st, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, 1 dc in the next 12 st, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Rounds 5–7: 2 dc in the first st, [ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc] repeat to the tip, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, [1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st] repeat until you have 1 st and the tch left, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Rounds 8–10: 2dc in the first st, 1 dc in each st until the tip, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, 1 dc in each st until the tch, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Round 11: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc, skip 3 st, [3 dc in the same st, skip 3 dc] repeat until the tip, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, skip 3 st, [3dc in the same st, skip 3 dc] repeat until you have 1 dc and the tch left, 1 dc in the next st, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Round 12: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc, ch 2, skip 2 st [3 dc tog, ch 2] repeat up to the tip, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, ch 2, [3 dc tog, ch 2] repeat until you have 3 dc and the tch left, skip 2 st, 1 dc in the next st, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Round 13: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc in the next 3 st, [3 dc in the ch-sp, 1 dc, 3 dc in the ch-sp] repeat up to the tip, 1 dc in the next 2 st, [2 dc, ch 2, 2dc] in the tip, 1 dc in the next 2 st, [3 dc in the ch-sp, 1 dc, 3 dc in the ch-sp] repeat until you have 3 st and the tch left, 1 dc in the next 3 st, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Round 14–15: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc in each st up to the tip, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip, 1 dc in each st until the tch, [2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch, ch 4 and turn

Repeat rounds 5-15 four times. Then repeat round 15 twice more.

Crochet a round of sc: ch 1, 1 sc in each st up to the tip, [1 sc, ch 1, 1 sc] in the tip, 1 sc in each st, 1 sc in the tch.

Edging:

Ch 1, 1 sl st in the first st, [1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 3 trc in the same st, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st]
repeat

Tassels

Crochet three pcs.

You will need a pair of scissors, something to wrap the yarn around, e.g. a crochet hook case or a wallet.

Super Cute Design



Make a magic ring. Do not close it completely.



Round 1: Ch 4,

4 dc,



ch 2,

4 dc,





1 trc



Ch 4 and turn



Round 2: 2 dc in the first st.



1 dc in the next 4 st.



[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip



1 dc in the next 4 st



[2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch



Ch 4 and turn

NB: Rnd. 3 and 4 are the same as rnd. 2, only with more stitches up to the tip, hence the picture guide will proceed to rnd. 5.



Round 5–7: 2 dc in the first st.



[ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc]





[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip



[1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st] repeat



[2 dc, 1 trc] in the tch







Round 8–10: 2 dc in the first st

1 dc in each st up to the tip



[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip



1 dc in each st



Round 11: 2 dc in the first st



1 dc, [skip 3 st



3 dc in the same st, skip 3 dc] repeat



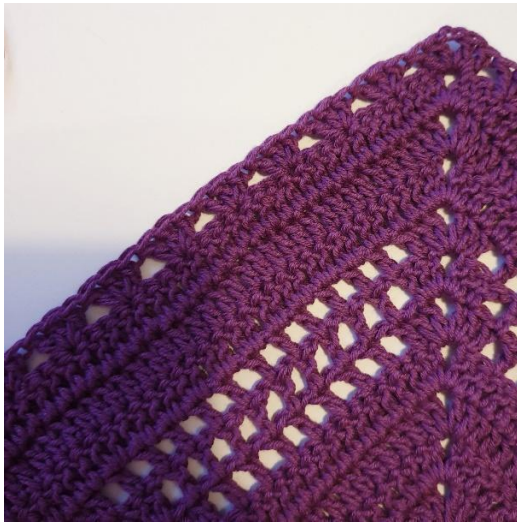
[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip





[Skip 3 st, 3 dc in the same st, skip 3 dc]
repeat





Round 12: 2 dc in the first st, 1 dc, ch 2, skip 2 st [3 dc tog, ch 2] repeat





[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the tip



ch 2, [3 dc tog, ch 2]

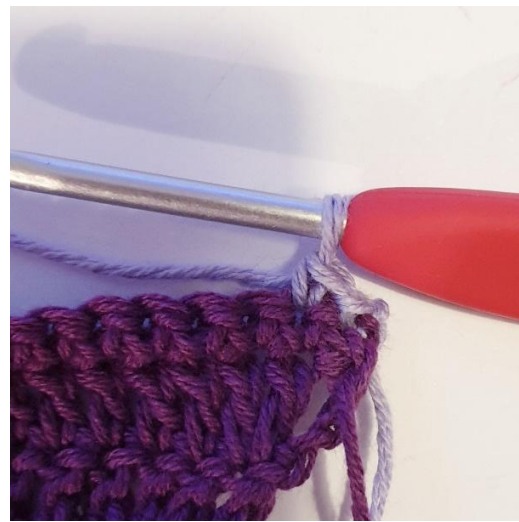




Edging



ch 1, 1 sl st in the first st



[1 sc,



1 hdc,



1 dc,



3 trc in the same st,



1 dc,



1 hdc,



1 sc,



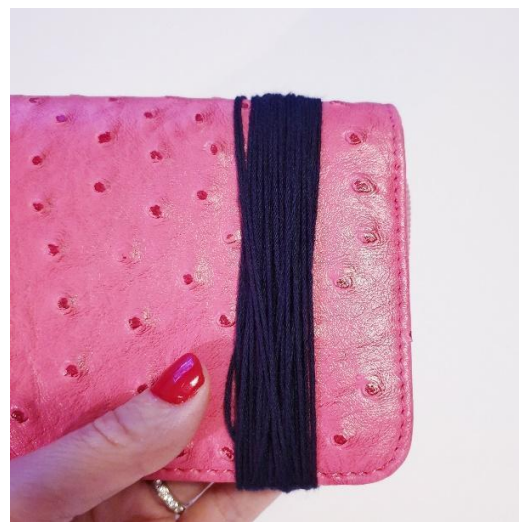
1 sl st]



[1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 3 trc in the same st, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st] repeat



Wrap the yarn around a casing



Count the rounds – I made 30 rounds.



Take a piece of yarn and guide it in under the rounds, pull up and make a knot.



Pull the yarn off the casing.



Take a piece of yarn and place it under your tassel



Make a knot ca. 1 cm from the tip



Make three pieces.



Sew the tassels on
