



Spinel - Shawl

Materials

2 skeins Universe color 18 4 skeins Diablo color 38

Circular needle 32" (80 cm)/ size 8 (5 mm) 2 markers

Yarn quality

Universe, Hobbii 98% Premium acrylic, 2% polyester/ 3.5 oz (100 g) = 505 yds (462 meter) Diablo, Hobbii 40% acrylic, 30% mohair, 30% polyamide/ 0.9 oz (25 g) = 246 yds (225 meter)

Gauge

17 sts and 34 rows on 4" (10 cm) in garter st using 1 strand of each quality.

Measurements

Width approx. 63" (160 cm) Length approx. 32¹/₂" (83 cm)

Pattern information

Knit with 1 strand of each quality. The shawl is knit from the top down. Start with a little square in the back of the neck. Increase on each side and in the middle.

Explanation

Inc 1 st: Put the needle under the chain between the sts and knit it so small holes are made.

Pattern

All of the shawl is knit using 1 strand of each quality, including the tassel.

Cast on with a square

Begin with a little square: Cast on 3 sts and knit 8 rows. Don't turn, but knit up 3 sts along the left side = 6 sts. Don't turn, but knit up 3 sts along the left side = 9 sts.

Continue with increases

1st row, wrong side: k9.

2nd row, right side: k3, inc 1, k1, inc 1, k1, inc 1, k1, inc 1, k3 = 4 sts increased = 13 sts. **3rd row:** k6, place a marker before the center st, k1, place a marker after the center st, k6. **4th row:** k3, inc 1, k3, inc 1, k1 (center st), inc 1, k3, inc 1, k3 = 17 sts. **5th row:** k17. **6th row:** k3, inc 1, k5, inc 1, k1 (center st), inc 1, k5, inc 1, k3 = 21 sts. **7th row:** k21. **8th row:** k3, inc 1, k7, inc 1, k1 (center st), inc 1, k7, inc 1, k3 = 25 sts. **9th row:** k25. **10th row:** k3, inc 1, k9, inc 1, k1 (center st), inc 1, k9, inc 1, k3 = 29 sts. **11th row:** k29.

Rep this inc with 4 sts on every other row until the shawl measures approx. $32\frac{1}{2}$ " (83 cm) in height at the center st.

Cast off loosely while making increases like before.

Tassel

Approx. 0.3-0.35 oz. (8-10 g) of yarn is used for the tassel.

Take a piece of card board with a width of approx. 2.8" (7 cm). Wind the yarn around the card board to a fitting thickness.

Take a piece of yarn of approx. 10" (25 cm) and tie it around the yarn on one of the sides of the top of the card board and tie a few knots, not too tightly. The knot is tightened later. Remove the card board. Take a piece of yarn and wind around the yarn about $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the knot and tie a few knots. Pull in the ends and hide in the tassel. Cut open in the opposite end from the knot.

Loosen the knot in the top and tie a few knots tightly around the yarn. Sew the tassel to the tip of the shawl.
