

## Grenade - Domino shawl

No. 2004-201-5949

## Materials

2 skeins of Winter Glow col. 06
Size $8(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ needle
Crochet hook size C/2-D/3 (3 mm) for edge
Stitch markers
Yarn quality
Winter Glow, Hobbii
$51 \%$ wool, 49\% acrylic/
7.1 oz . $(200 \mathrm{~g})=766 \mathrm{yds}(700$ meter $)$

Measurements
Width: 61" ( 155 cm )
Length: 28.7" ( 73 cm )

## Gauge

18 stitches and 40 rows for 4 " ( 10 cm )
1 domino
Height: 6" (15 cm)
Diagonal: 6.3" (16 cm)

## Pattern information

The shawl is knitted in rows of domino squares.
Each row is finished with a half domino. Finally, you crochet an edge around the whole shawl.

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## Abbreviations

st: stitch
r: row
tbl: through back loop only
tog: together
sl1: put right needle through the stitch from left to right; with yarn behind the work
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together
k2tog tbl: knit 2 stitches together but through back loop only
k3tog: s11, k2tog, draw slipped st over
sc: single crochet
ch: chain

## Pattern

## First row

## First domino

Cast on 47 sts.
1st row (wrong side): sl1, knit across.
Place a marker around the center st.
2nd row (right side): sl1, knit to 1 st before marker, k3tog, knit across. Repeat these 2 rows until you've got 3 sts left.
Next row (right side): sl1, k2tog, draw slipped st over $=1$ st left.

## Second domino

Knit up 23 sts along the left side of the domino (right side) $=24$ sts, cast on 23 sts using a knitted cast on = 47 sts.
Place a marker around the center st.
1st row (wrong side): knit across.
2nd row (right side): sl1, knit to 1 st before marker, k3tog, knit across.
3rd row (wrong side): sl1, knit across.
Finish the domino like the first domino.

## Thrid domino

Is knitted like the second domino.
Continue until you've got 8 dominoes all in all.

## Half domino

Knit up 23 sts along the left side of the domino (right side) $=24$ sts, cast on 23 sts using a knitted cast on = 47 sts.
1st row (wrong side): knit across.
2nd row (right side): s11, k2tog tbl, knit to 1 st before marker, k3tog, knit to 3 sts left, k2tog, k1.
3rd row: sl1 pw, knit across.
Continue decreasing in both sides and in the middle until there's 7 sts left.
Bind off loosely from the wrong side. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

## Second row

## First domino

Cast on 24 sts, knit up 23 sts along the right side of the first domino of the first row from the right side $=47$ sts.
1st row (wrong side): sl1, knit across.
Place a marker around the center stitch.
2ns row (right side): sl1, knit to 1 st before marker, k3tog, knit across. Finish the domino like the first domino.

## Second domino

Knit up 23 sts along the left side of the domino, knit up 23 sts along the other domino of the first row $=47$ sts.
1st row (wrong side): knit across. Place a marker around the center st.
2nd row (right side): sl1, knit to 1 st before marker, k3tog, knit across.
3rd row (wrong side): sl1, knit across.
Finish the domino like the first domino.
Continue until you've got 7 dominoes all in all on this row.
Knit a half domino like before.
Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
Continue on the third row with 6 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue on the fourth row with 5 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue on the fifth row with 4 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue on the sixth row with 3 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue on the seventh row with 2 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue on the eighth row with 1 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue on the nineth row with 1 half domino.
Weave in all ends.

## Edge

1st rnd: Work 1 rnd of sc along all edges.
2nd rnd: (ch 3, skip 1 st, sc 1 ) around.
Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
