



Donau - Ladies socks

No. 2004-201-2483



Materials

3 (3) 4 balls Happy Feet XL col. 511

Double pointed needles size 4,5 mm Stitch markers

Yarn

75% Superwash wool, 25% Nylon / 50 g = 106 meter

Size

Shoe size: 36-37 (38-39) 40-41 Foot length: approx. 24 (26) 28 cm

Gauge

20 stitches = 10 cm in twisted rib with two strands of yarn.

Pattern information

The socks are worked with two strands of yarn. They are worked in the round in twisted rib (p1, k1 tbl).

You work a short rib before the heel.

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Have fun making this pattern!



Shaft

CO 36 (40) 44 stitches with 2 strands and distribute them on 4 double pointed needles. Work twisted rib in the round: k1 tbl, p1.

Continue until shaft measures 5 cm.

Divide for the heel

Place half of the stitches on 2 double pointed needles = 18 (20) 22 stitches.

NB! Rest the stitches for the foot on 2 other double pointed needles.

Heel

Work stockinette stitch, back and forth, over the 18 (20) 22 stitches for the heel until piece measures 5 (5,5) 6 cm. Finish with a WS needle.

Insert a marker in the middle of the heel, having 9 (10) 11 stitches on each side. Measure the piece from here.

Work the decreases on the heel follows:

1st row (RS): Work until there are 4 (5) 6 stitches left, k2tog tbl, k1, turn.

2nd row (WS): Work until there are 4 (5) 6 stitches left, p2tog, p1, turn.

3rd row (RS): Work until there are 3 (4) 5 stitches left, k2tog tbl, k1, turn.

4th row (WS): Work until there are 3 (4) 5 stitches left, p2tog, p1, turn.

Continue working 1 stitch less before decreasing until all stitches on needle are worked.

NB On the last 2 rows you respectively knit 2 sts together and purl 2 sts together.

On next row you pick up 9 (10) 11 stitches on each side of the heel. Distribute the heel-stitches over 2 double pointed needles.

Continue in stockinette stitch.

Insert a marker in the transition between heel and top of the foot and distribute the stitches so you have 19 (21) 23 for the top of the foot (first and last stitch are purl stitches).

Continue working the stitches on top of the foot in twisted rib, and the stitches under the foot in stockinette stitch.



Gusset

Decrease for the gusset as follows:

Work until 2 stitches before first marker, k2tog, work the stitches on top of the foot in twisted rib until second marker, k2tog tbl, work the rest of sts on round in stockinette stitch.

Work 1 round.

Continue like this and decrease in every 2nd round until you have 36 (40) 44 stitches left on the needles.

On next round, k2tog on each side of the top of the foot = 34 (38) 42 stitches.

Foot

Continue working all stitches until piece measures 19 (20,5) 22 cm from marker in heel = you still need to work 5 (5,5) 6 cm for the toe.

Toe

Insert 1 marker in each side, so you have 17 (19) 21 stitches for both sides of the foot. Work until first marker.

Begin decreasing as follows:

1st round:

1st and 2nd double pointed needle: k1, k2tog tbl, work until 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1.

3rd and 4th double pointed needle: k1, k2tog tbl, work until 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1.

2nd round:

Knit all stitches.

Repeat the decreases in each side on every 2nd round until there are 14 stitches left on the needles.

Finish

Bind off all stitches.

Sew the hole in the toe together in Kitchener stitch.

Work another sock in the same way.
