



## Ziggy – Baby Blanket

No. 1001-201-5854

### Materials:

- 1 skein Sultan Deluxe, color 31
- Crochet hook, 3 mm

### Buy yarn here:

### Gauge:

24 sts x 11 rows = 10 x 10 cm  
(Measured before blocking)

### Measurements

**Before blocking:** 76x66 cm.

**After blocking:** 81x69 cm.

### Abbreviations

**Ch:** chain stitch

**St(s):** stitch(es)

**Sc:** single crochet

**Hdc:** half double crochet

**Dc:** double crochet

**NB:** The turning chain stitches DO NOT replace any stitches.

**3 dc tog:** (yo, pick up yarn under next st, yo, pull yarn through 2 loops on hook) 3 times (= 4 loops on the hook), yo and pull through all loops on hook.

## **Pattern instructions – Guide with pictures at the end of the instructions**

Chain 163.

### **Base row:**

1. Work 1dc in each of the first 3 sts (first dc is worked in the 3<sup>rd</sup> st from the hook). \* hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row, but end with 1 dc in each of the last 3 sts.
2. Ch 2 and turn work.  
Repeat base row: dc in the first 3 sts. \* hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row, but end with 1 dc in each of the last 3 sts.

### **Continue in pattern rows:**

3. Ch 2 and turn work.  
2 dc in first st. \* dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc tog, dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc in the next st \*. Repeat between \*\*, but with only 2dc in the last st.

Repeat the pattern row (row 3) until you have 90 rows in total.

### **Finishing row:**

91. Ch 1 and turn work.  
Work sc in the first 3 sts. \* hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row, but end with 1 sc in each of the last 3 sts.
92. Ch 1 and turn work.  
Repeat the finishing row. Work sc in the first 3 sts. \* hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row, but end with 1 sc in each of the last 3 sts. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

**Guide - Base rows:**



**1.** Start by making your foundation chain. Begin your first row in the 3<sup>rd</sup> st from the hook.



**2.** 1 dc in each of the first 3 sts.



**3.** Hdc in the next 3 sts.



**4.** Sc in the next 5 sts.



**5.** Hdc in the next 3 sts.



**6.** Dc in the next 5 sts.



7. \* hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts \*.



8. Repeat between \*\* until end of row, but end with 3 dc.



9. Ch 2 and turn work.



10. Repeat base row: dc in the first 3 sts. \* hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row, but end with 1 dc in each of the last 3 sts.

**Guide - Pattern rows:**



**1.** Ch 2 and turn work. Make 2 dc in the first st.



**2.** Like so.



**3.** Dc in the next 6 sts.



**4.** 3 dc tog.



**5.** Dc in the next 6 sts.



**6.** 3 dc in the next st.



**7.** \* dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc tog, dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc in the next st \*. Repeat between \*\*, but with only 2dc in the last st..



**8.** Like so.



**9.** Repeat the 3<sup>rd</sup> row.



**10.** 2 dc in the first st.



**11.** Dc in the next 6 sts.



**12.** 3 dc tog.



**13.** Dc in the next 6 sts.



**14.** 3 dc in the next st.



**15.** \* dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc tog, dc in the next 6 sts, 3 dc in the next st \*. Repeat between \*\*, but with only 2dc in the last st..



**16.** Like so.



Repeat the pattern row until you have 90 rows in total.

**Guide - Finishing row:**



**1.** Ch 1 and turn work. Sc in the first 3 sts.



**2.** Hdc in the next 3 sts.



**3.** Dc in the next 5 sts.



**4.** Hdc in the next 3 sts.



**5.** Sc in the next 5 sts.



**6.** \* hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row,



7. but end with 1 sc in each of the last 3 sts.



8. Now repeat the finishing row. Ch 1 and turn work.



9. Sc in the first 3 sts. \* hdc in the next 3 sts, dc in the next 5 sts, hdc in the next 3 sts, sc in the next 5 sts \*. Repeat between \*\* until the end of row, but end with 1 sc in each of the last 3 sts. Cut yarn and weave in ends



It can be beneficial to block your blanket to avoid the edges rolling or folding over.
