



## Monsun – Beanie and Scarf

## Materials

### Beanie

1 (1) 2 (2) skeins Woolpower color 22

Circular needle 80 cm/ 5 mm

### Scarf

2 skeins Woolpower color 22

Circular needle 80 cm/ 8 mm

Pompom maker 8,5 cm

## Yarn quality

**Woolpower**, Happy Sheep

100% wool, 100 g = 160 meters

## Gauge

17 sts = 10 cm on a 5 mm needle

13 sts = 10 cm on an 8 mm needle

## Size

### Beanie

S (M) L (XL)

### Scarf

One size

## Measurements

### Beanie

Circumference: 46 (50) 54 (56) cm –

Stretchy width-wise.

### Scarf

Width: 20 cm, laying double

Length, excluding pompon: 100 cm

## Pattern information

**Beanie** is worked in the round from the bottom up. It is worked in stockinette with the Magic Loop technique. There is no ribbed edge, so the cast on edge will roll. One pompom is made of the same yarn and sewn onto the top.

**Scarf** is worked in stockinette in the round with the Magic Loop technique.

Two pompoms are made from the same yarn and one is sewn to each end of the scarf.

## Beanie

Cast on 80 (85) 90 (95) sts on a 5 mm circular needle and work in stockinette in the round until the work measures about 28-30 cm.

### Start decreases

1. round: \* k3, k2tog \* Repeat between \*\* to end of round.
2. round: knit.
3. round: \* k2, k2tog \* Repeat between \*\* to end of round.
4. round: knit.
5. round: \* k1, k2tog \* Repeat between \*\* to end of round.
6. round: knit.
7. round: \* k2tog \* Repeat between \*\* to end of round.

Break the yarn.

Pull the tail yarn through the sts of the last round and tighten to close the hole. Weave in end on the wrong side.

Make a pompom of 8,5 cm in diameter.

Steam it over boiling water to make it fluff up. Sew onto the top of the beanie.

## Scarf

Cast on 54 sts on an 8 mm circular needle and work in stockinette in the round until the scarf measures about 100 cm.

Do not bind off, but break the yarn and pull the tail end through the open sts on the needle. Tighten and weave in to secure.

For the cast-on edge, thread a piece of yarn through the sts of the edge and pull tight.

Weave in and secure.

Make two pompoms of 8,5 cm in diameter.

Steam them over boiling water to make them fluff up. Sew onto each end of the scarf.
