



# Ladybug - Rattle

No. 1009-202-8139

**Difficulty:** Intermediate **Crochet hook:** 2.5 mm

**Materials:** Tapestry needle & 1 rattle box

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4

You need:

White (1): 1 skein

Dark Red (59): 1 skein

Dark Green (22): 1 skein

Black (9): 1 skein

Sunny Yellow (55): 1 skein

**Abbreviations:** 

MR = magic ring sc = single crochet sl st = slip stitch ch = chain stitch dc = double crochet

(...) repeat

{...} number of rows
[...] number of stitches
sc2in1 = make 2 sc in 1 st
sc2tog = make 1 sc in 1 st

**BL** = work only in the back loop of st **FL** = work only in the front loop of st

#### Begin with Dark Red (59):

R1: 6 sc in a MR [6]
R2: (sc2in1) 6x [12]
R3: (1 sc, sc2in1) 6x [18]
R4: (2 sc, sc2in1) 6x [24]
R5: (3 sc, sc2in1) 6x [30]
R6: (4 sc, sc2in1) 6x [36]

**R7:** (5 sc, sc2in1) 6x [42]

**R8:** (6 sc, sc2in1) 6x [48]

**R9-15**: 1 sc in every st {7 rounds} [48]

**R16: BL** (6 sc, sc2tog) 6x [42] **R17:** (5 sc, sc2tog) 6x [36] **R18:** (2 sc, sc2tog) 9x [27] **R19:** (1 sc, sc2tog) 9x [18]

Fill stuffing in the rattle head and place the rattle box in it. Fill the handle of the rattle as you work.

Cut yarn and bind off the Dark Red (59). Continue, using Dark Green (22).

#### Stripes:

Now, the stripes on the handle is worked. Each stripe is 4 rounds.

Green: **R20-23:** 1 sc in every st [18] White: **R24-27:** 1 sc in every st [18] Green: **R28-31:** 1 sc in every st [18] White: **R32-35:** 1 sc in every st [18]

#### Green:

R36-39: 1 sc in every st [18]

**R40:** (1 sc, sc2tog) 6x [12], stuff well.

**R41**: (sc2tog) 6x [6]

Cut yarn and thread the tail end through the front loops of R41. Tighten and bind off.

**Black stripe:** Make a length of ch st that fits over the red part. Beginning in the second st from the hook, sc in every st back. Cut the yarn with a long tail and bind off. Use the tail to sew onto the red head of the rattle with small stitches.

<sup>\*</sup>The rattle is worked as one piece except for the green scalloped edge and black accents.



#### Dots:

using Black (9): make 6 small and 3 large.

Small: **R1:** 6 sc in a MR [6], join with sl into the first st. Cut yarn with a long tail and bind off. Use the tail to sew onto the red part with small stitches.

Stor: **R1**: 10 sc in a MR [10], join with sl into the first st. Cut yarn with a long tail and bind off. Use the tail to sew onto the red part with small stitches.

### Scalloped edge:

Using Dark Green (22):

**R16:** Working in FL: loop through (skip 2 sts, 5 sc in next st, skip 2 sts, sl st into next st) x8. Cut yarn and bind off.

# Embroider the tulips:

On the white stripes, embroider the tulips as such: Embroider a green V and a yellow V above that.
