



Gitte - Sweater

Materials

5 (5, 6) skeins of Baby Wool fv 07 7 (8, 9) skeins of Kid Silk fv 28 (held double)

Stitch markers

Needles 6 mm and 8 mm

Yarn

Baby Wool, Happy Sheep 100% Wool/ 50 g = 165 meters **Kid Silk**, Hobbii 70% Kid Mohair, 30% Silk/ 25 g = 195 meters

Gauge

14,5 sts and 20 rows = 10 cm in moss stitch on 8 mm needle with 3 strands (1 Baby Wool, 2 Kid Silk)

Size S (M, L)

Measurements

Width: 47 (57, 67) cm

Length: 46 (48, 50) cm. The sweater will get longer with use due to being worked

on big needles.

Pattern information

The sweater is worked with 1 stand of Baby Wool and 2 stands
Kid Silk = 3 strands.
Back, front and sleeves are worked as separate pieces.
This is a short model, so please try the sewater on to test the sleeve length.

Moss stitch

1st row: *k1, p1*, repeat from * to * to end of row.

2nd row: work p over k and k over p.

Repeat the 2nd row.

Abbreviations

RS: right side. WS: wrong side.

M1: make one = pick up bar between sts from the front with the left needle and knit through

back loop.

Back

Rib edge

Cast on 69 (83, 97) sts on a 6mm needle.

Work in rib.

WS: p1, *k1, p1*, repeat from * to* until end of row.

RS: k1, *p1, k1*, repeat from * to* until end of row.

Work 5 rows of rib in total.

Body

Change to an 8 mm needle and work in moss stitch until work measures 46 (48, 50) cm.

Shoulder and neck

Bind off 18 (24, 30) sts for shoulder and work to end of row.

Bind off 18 (24, 30) sts for shoulder and place 33 (35, 37) sts on a stitch holder for neck.

Front

Worked as back until it measures 40 (42, 44) cm. End with a wrong side row.

Neckline

RS: work 25 (31, 37) sts, lest the remaining sts rest.

WS: Bind off 4 sts and work rest of row.

RS: Moss stitch.

WS: Bind off 3 sts and work rest of row = 18 (24, 30) sts for shoulder.

RS: Moss stitch. **WS:** Moss stitch.

Continue until work measures 46 (48, 50) cm.

Bind off the 18 (24, 30) sts of the shoulder.

Place the middle 19 (21, 23) sts on a stitch holder.

RS: Pick up yarn and work the remaining 25 (31, 37) sts.

WS: Moss stitch.



RS: Bind off 4 sts and work rest of row.

WS: Moss stitch.

RS: Bind off 3 sts and work rest of row.

WS: Moss stitch.

Continue until work measures 46 (48, 50) cm.

Bind of the 18 (24, 30) sts of the shoulder.

Sleeve

Cast on 37 sts on a 6 mm needle and work 5 rows of rib like on the back.

On the last row, increase 9 sts evenly along the row = 46 sts.

Change to 8 mm needles and work in moss stitch for 6 cm.

Start increases

M1 at beginning and end of row = 48 sts.

*work 8 (7, 6) cm moss stitch.

M1 at beginning and end of row*, repeat until there are 54 sts.

Work moss stitch until the sleeve measures approx. 42 cm.

Bind off.

NB This is a wide model, so make sure to measure the sweater and sleeve for the right fit and length.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

Finishing and neckline

Sew left shoulder seam.

Pick up about 70 (74, 78) sts on RS in neckline edge on a 6mm needle. Work 6 rows of rib as described earlier.

Bind off in rib, not too tightly, or with a stretchy bind-off.

Sew the other shoulder seam and the neckline.

Sew the sleeves to the body. Sew the side seam and sleeve seam.
