Materials

All sizes

3 balls Diablo color 31

3 balls Diablo color 25

3 balls Diablo color 37

3 balls Diablo color 10

Scrap yarn for cast on

Needles: 7 mm & 9 mm circular needles, 80 cm

Yarn

Diablo, Hobbii

30% Mohair, 30% Nylon, 40% Acrylic/

25 g = 225 m

Gauge

Knit with four strands on larger needles:

11 sts & 14 rows = 10 cm

Sizes

S/M (M/L, L/XL)

Measurements

Width: 55 (60, 65) cm

Length: 62 (63, 64) cm

Pattern information

The sweater is knit with four strands of Diablo from the bottom up. The sleeves are knit from the top down by picking up stitches along the armhole. All edges are finished with i-cord bind off.

Have fun knitting!

Tip

In order to knit with four strands of the same color, you can split two balls into four smaller balls = 12,5 grams each. Then you can knit with one big and three small balls = four strands.

Pattern note

Color change for jogless stripes

Row 1: Attach new color and knit until last stitch of round, slip stitch knitwise and knit together with the loop behind the stitch from previous row.

Row 2: Knit all stitches with new color.

Pattern instructions

Cast on edge

Provisional cast on

Cast on 120 (132, 144) stitches with scrap yarn on 9 mm circular needles, join to knit in the round, knit 1 row. The provisional cast on will be removed when the i-cord is attached later.

Body

Change to 4 strands of Diablo color 31 and proceed to knit in the round.

Knit 19 rows total of stockinette stitch = 14 cm.

Change to color 25 and knit 19 rows of stockinette stitch = 14 cm (see pattern note for color change).

Change to color 37 and knit 19 rows of stockinette stitch = 14 cm.

Body measures 42 cm.

Change to color 10 and knit 2 rows of stockinette stitch.

Place stitch marker at each side marking the side seam, 60 (66, 72) stitches for front and back.

Split work for armholes – place the front stitches on holder, and proceed to knit the back.

Back

Continue with color 10, working stockinette stitch back and forth. Knit until armhole measures 20 (21, 22) cm, ending with a purl row.

Bind off 22 (24, 26) stitches, knit to end of row.

Bind off 22 (24, 26) stitches.

Neckline

Place remaining 16, (18, 20) stitches on a holder.

Front

Place stitch marker at the center of the front = 30 (33, 36) stitches on each side. Work each side separately back and forth in color 10.

Begin V-neck

Left side (your left when sweater is on)

Row 1, right side: knit 28 (31, 34) stitches, knit 2 together.

Row 2, wrong side: purl.

Repeat these two rows until 22 (24, 26) stitches remain.

Continue without decreasing until armhole measures 20 (21, 22) cm, ending with a purl row.

Bind off.

Right side

Row 1, right side: knit 2 together through back loop, knit to end.

Row 2, wrong side: purl.

Repeat these two rows until 22 (24, 26) stitches remain.

Continue without decreasing until armhole measures 20 (21, 22) cm, ending with a purl row.

Bind off.

Shoulder seams

Graft shoulder seams together.

Sleeves (knit from the top down)

Pick up 42 (44, 46) stitches evenly along armhole edge with 7 mm needle in color 37.

Place stitch marker at beginning of round.

Change to 9 mm needle and knit in the round using magic loop.

Knit 9 rows.

Begin decreases

Knit until 3 stitches remain before marker, knit 2 together through back loop, knit 2, knit 2 together = 2 stitches decreased.

Decrease every 6 rows while knitting stripes, until 26 (28, 30) stitches remain.

Knit a total of 18 rows stockinette stitch in color 37 = 13 cm.

Change to color 25 and knit 18 rows stockinette stitch.

Change to color 31 and knit 18 rows stockinette stitch, stopping decreases when there are 26 (28, 30) stitches left. Sleeve measures 39 cm.

I-cord bind off:

Change to 7 mm needle and bind off using the i-cord method:

Cast on 3 stitches using the knitted cast-on, place stitches on the left needle.

Knit 2, knit 2 together through back loop, slip 3 stitches from the right needle to the left needle, repeat from * to * until all stitches have been knit.

Graft the i-cord edges together using kitchener stitch.

Knit second sleeve to match.

I-cord edges

Neckline

From the right side, pick up stitches along front edge with a 7 mm needle in color 10. Place live neck stitches on needle. Bind off all around the neckline using the i-cord method as described for sleeves.

Bottom edge

Remove scrap yarn, place live stitches on 7 mm circular needle. Bind off using the i-cord method in color 31, as described for sleeves.
