

## Jade - Domino Shawl

## Materials

3 skeins of Magic Sock Wool col. 06
Knitting needle US size 6 ( 4 mm )
Crochet hook US size C/2 $(3 \mathrm{~mm})$ for crocheting the edge
Stitch markers
Yarn Quality
Magic Sock Wool, Happy Sheep
70\% wool, 30\% polyamide/
$3.5 \mathrm{oz} .(100 \mathrm{~g})=437 \mathrm{yds}(400 \mathrm{~m})$

## Measurements

Width: 61 inches ( 155 cm )
Length: 28.7 inches ( 73 cm )

## Knitting gauge

18 stitches and 40 rows on 4 inches (10 cm)

1 domino
Height: 5.9 inches ( 15 cm )
Diagonally: 6.3 inches ( 16 cm )

## Pattern information

The shawl is knitted in strips of dominos.
Each strip is finished with a half domino. Lastly, an edge is crocheted around the entire shawl.

## Abbreviations

st: stitch
n : needle
tbl: through the back loop
tog: together
slip 1 stitch knitwise: insert the right needle into the stitch from left to the right with the yarn behind your work
2 sts tog knitwise: knit 2 stitches together.
2 sts tog tbl knitwise: knit 2 stitches together knitwise, but through the back loops.
3 sts tog knitwise: slip 1 stitch, knit 2 sts together knitwise, pass the slipped stitch over.
sc: single crochet
ch: chain stitch

## Pattern

## First strip

First domino
Cast on 47 stitches.

1. row (wrong side): slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit the rest of the needle. Place a marker around the middle stitch.
2. row (right side): slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit until 1 st before the marker, 3 sts tog knitwise, knit the rest of the needle. Repeat these 2 rows until you have 3 sts left.
Next row (right side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit 2 sts together, pass the slipped stitch over $=1$ st left.

## Second domino

Knit 23 sts up along the left side of the domino (the right side) $=24$ sts, knit up 23 sts using the knitted-cast-on-technique $=47$ sts. Place a marker around the middle stitch.

1. row (wrong side): knit the rest of the needle.
2. row (right side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit until 1 st before the marker, 3 sts tog knitwise, knit the rest of the needle.
3. row (wrong side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit the rest of the needle.

Knit the rest of the domino just like you knitted the first domino.

## Third domino

Work it as the second domino.
Continue until you have 8 dominos in total.

## Half domino

Knit up 23 sts along the left side of the domino (right side) $=24$ sts, cast on 23 sts using the knitted-cast-on-technique $=47$ sts.

1. row (wrong side): knit the rest of the needle.
2. row (right side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit 2 sts tog tbl, knit until 1 st before the marker, 3 sts tog knitwise, knit until you have 3 sts left, knit 2 sts tog, knit 1.
3. row: slip 1 st purlwise, knit the rest of the needle.

Continue working decreases on each side and the middle until you have 7 sts left.
Bind off loosely from the wrong side. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

## Second strip

## First domino

Cast on 24 sts. From the right side, knit up 23 sts along the right side of the first domino of the first strip $=47$ sts.

1. row (wrong side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit the rest of the needle.

Place a marker around the middle stitch.
2. row (right side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit until 1 st before the marker, 3 sts tog knitwise, knit the rest of the needle. Work the rest of the domino just like you knitted the first domino.

## Second domino

Knit up 23 sts along the left side of the domino, knit up 23 sts along the second of the first strip $=47$ sts.

1. row (wrong side): knit the rest of the needle. Place a marker around the middle stitch.
2. row (right side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit until 1 st before the marker, 3 sts tog knitwise, knit the rest of the needle.
3. row (wrong side): slip 1 st knitwise, knit the rest of the needle.

Work the rest of the domino just like you knitted the first domino.

Continue until you have 7 dominos on this strip in total.

Work a half domino like you did previously.
Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Continue to the third strip with 6 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue to the fourth strip with 5 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue to the fifth strip with 4 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue to the sixth strip with 3 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue to the seventh strip with 2 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue to the eight strip with 1 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue to the ninth strip with 1 half domino.
Weave in all ends.

## Edge

1. rnd: crochet 1 round of sc along all edges.
2. rnd: (chain 3, skip 1 st, 1 sc ) around.

Fasten off and weave in the ends.
