



Snurre - Espadrilles

Materials

1 skein Rainbow Bamboo col. 09

Espadrilles soles Knitting mill / i-cord machine 2 double pointed needles, 2 mm, to bind off cords

Yarn quality
Rainbow Bamboo, Hobbii
60% Bamboo, 40% Cotton/
50 g = 125 meters

Pattern information

You make 3 cords on the knitting mill for each sandal (6 in all)
These cords are fastened to the soles at the forefoot and the ankle, where you tie them in a bow to fasten them.



Try on the shoe to make sure the cords fit the width of your forefoot.

The shown sandals are size EU 38 /UK 5.

Knit cord

Use the knitting mill to make 3 i-cords for each sandal: one 40 cm cord for the forefoot and two 75 cm cords for ties at the ankles. You can also make one continuous cord and cut it as you sew it to the sole of the sandal.

Finishing

Left sandal

Forefoot: A, B, C, D

Take a 40 cm cord and bind off one end as such: place the 4 sts on a double pointed needle and bind off = \mathbf{A} . Sew the end to the sole about 3 cm down the right side from the toe of the sole = big toe.

Measure about 10 cm along the cord = **B** and sew the point to the sole about 7 cm down the left side from the toe of the sole = pinky toe.

Measure about 11-12 cm along the cord = \mathbf{C} and sew the point to the sole about 9 cm down the right side from the toe of the sole.

Unravel the end of the cord until it measures 13 cm from \mathbf{C} . Place the 4 sts onto a double pointed needle and bind off = \mathbf{D} . Sew the end to the sole about 12 cm down the left side from the toe of the sole.

Ankle ties: E, F

Take a 75 cm cord and bind off one end like so: Place the 4 sts onto a double pointed needle and bind off = **E**. Sew the bind-off to the sole about 3 cm up the left side from the heel of the sole.

Unravel the other end of the cord until it measures about 70 cm. Place the sts into a double pointed needle and bind off.



Take the other 75 cm cord and bind off at one end like described above = **F**. Sew the bind-off to the sole about 3 cm up the right side from the heel of the sole.

Unravel the other end of the cord until it measures about 70 cm. Place the sts into a double pointed needle and bind off.

Finish the **right sandal** in the same manner, but mirrored.
