Materials

2 (2) 2 skeins Twister Solid col 129
2 (3) 3 skeins Friends Kid Silk col 77

4 mm needles

Yarn

Twister Solid, Hobbii

55% Cotton, 45% Acrylic/
100 g = 400 meters

Kid Silk, Hobbii

70% Kid Mohair, 30% Silk/
25 g = 195 meters

Gauge

18 sts og 30 rows for 10 cm in pattern

Sizes

S (M) L

Measurements

Width: 44 (48) 52 cm

Length: 50 (53) 56 cm

Pattern information

The blouse is worked bottom and up.
The sleeves are made separately and
sewn onto the armholes. See pictures
at the end of the pattern instructions.

Pattern

Row 1, Twister Solid: knit.
Row 2, Twister Solid: purl.
Row 3, Kid Silk: knit.
Row 4, Kid Silk: knit.
Repeat these 4 rows.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Back piece

Cast on 80 (86) 92 sts in Twister Solid and knit 4 rows.

Continue in the pattern until the piece measures 32 (34) 36 cm.

Armholes: Bind off 6 (7) 8 sts in both sides = 68 (72) 76 sts.

Work straight up until the piece measures 48 (51) 54 cm. End with 2 rows of Twister Solid.

Bind off.

Place a marker 18 (19) 20 sts in from both sides.

Front piece

Worked as the back until it measures 41 (44) 47 cm.

Neckline: Knit 18 (19) 20, let these sts rest, bind off 32 (34) 36 sts and knit the rest of the row.

Continue straight up until the piece measures 50 (53) 56 cm = shoulder.

Knit 2 (2) 2 cm straight up. End with 1 row of Twister Solid. Bind off.

Work the other shoulder in the same manner.

Sew up, or knit together, the shoulder seams until the markers.

Sleeves

Cast on 40 (42) 44 sts in Twister Solid and make the same edge as the back piece.

Continue in the pattern while increasing for every 10 rows until you have 64 (68) 72 sts.

Work straight up until the sleeve measures about 50 cm. End with 2 rows of Twister Solid.

Bind off in Twister Solid.

Make the other sleeve in the same manner.

Neckline

Pick up stitches along the neckline using Twister Solid and knit 4 rounds while working decreases (k2tog) in the corners (4 times) on each round. Bind off loosely, cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Finishing

Sew the sleeve to the notch in the armhole, sew the top 3-4 cm of the sleeve to the bound-off edge of the armhole, sew up the rest of the sleeve seams.

Sew up the side seams.



The sleeve is sewn to the blouse in the notch of the armhole, and the top of the sleeve seam is sewn to the bound-off edge.
