Skill level: Intermediate

Crochet hook: 6-B/1 **(**2.00 mm)

Measurement: 38 cm

Materials: A piece of left over black yarn for the eyes, 2 wooden buttons 15 mm,

filling

Yarn: Baby Cotton

Eucalyptus (#10) - 1 skein Cream (#02) - 1 skein Silver Grey (#03) - 1 skein Sky Blue (#07) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet sl st = slip stitch mr = magic ring inc = increase dec = decrease rnd = rounds tbl = through back loop

(xx) = brackets after the round = number

of stitches after finished round

ch = chain



Head:

In Cream

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Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.
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Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (48)

Rnd 9: (7 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (46)

Rnd 10: (8 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (60)

Rnd 11-20: 1 sc in every sc (60) 10 rounds

Rnd 21: (8 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (54)

Rnd 22: (7 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (48)

Rnd 23: (6 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (42)

Rnd 24: (5 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (36)

Rnd 25: (4 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (30)

Rnd 26: (3 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (24)

Rnd 27: (2 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (18)

Bind off with enough yarn for sewing.

Hood:

In Silver Grev

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.

Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (48)

Rnd 9: (7 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (54)

Rnd 10: (8 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (60)

Rnd 11-20: 1 sc in every sc (60) 10 Rounds

Bind off with enough yarn for sewing.

Now turn the work with ch 1 after every finished round.

Rnd 21: 15 sc tbl, ch 1, turn

Rnd 22: skip the first st, 14 sc, ch 1, turn

Rnd 23: skip the first st, 13 sc, ch 1, turn



Rnd 24: skip the first st, 12 sc, ch 1, turn
Rnd 25: skip the first st, 11 sc, ch 1, turn
Rnd 26: skip the first st, 10 sc, ch 1, turn
Rnd 27: skip the first st, 9 sc, ch 1, turn

Make a round of sc all the way around the cap.

See the picture on the last page.

Bind off with enough yarn for sewing.

Shoes and legs: Make 2.

In Silver Grey

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.

Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in every sc tbl (24)

Rnd 6-9: 1 sc in every sc (24) 4 rounds

Rnd 10: dec 5 times, 14 sc (19) Rnd 11: dec 4 times, 11 sc (15)

Rnd 12-13: 1 sc in every sc (15) 2 rounds

Rnd 14: 10 sc so we end up on the back of the foot so we don't see the change of color.

Switch to Cream

Fill up the foot tightly with filling and then a bit lighter up the leg while you work.

Rnd 14-41: 1 sc in every sc (15) 28 rounds

Bind off with enough yarn for sewing.

Body:

In Eucalyptus

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.

Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) Rep 6 times (48)

Rnd 9-17: 1 sc in every sc (48) 9 rounds

Rnd 18: (6 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (42)



Rnd 19-20: 1 sc in every sc (42) 2 rounds Rnd 21: (5 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (36) Rnd 22-23: 1 sc in every sc (36) 2 rounds Rnd 24: (4 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (30) Rnd 25-28: 1 sc in every sc (30) 4 rounds Rnd 29: (3 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (24) Rnd 30-36: 1 sc in every sc (24) 7 rounds Rnd 37: (2 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (18) Rnd 38-39: 1 sc in every sc (18) 2 rounds

Bind off.

Arms: Make 2.

In Cream

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.

Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3-21: 1 sc in every sc (12) 19 rounds

Remember to fill up the arm very lightly while you work.

Switch to Eucalyptus.

Rnd 22-29: 1 sc in every sc (12) 8 rounds

Bind off with enough yarn for sewing.

Pants:

In Sky Blue

Rnd 1: 24 sc in a big mr.

Don't tighten since this is the hole for pant leg.

Rnd 2: (1 sc, inc) Rep 12 times (36)

Rnd 3-16: 1 sc in every sc (36) 14 rounds

Bind off and make another. Don't break the yarn on pant leg no. 2.

Now make the rest of the pants:

Rnd 17: Now gather the pant legs using 1 sc in the last st on the first pant leg. Now work around both pant legs: 72 sc

Rnd 18-23: 1 sc in every sc (72) 6 rounds



Rnd 24: (10 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (66) Rnd 25-26: 1 sc in every sc (66) 2 rounds Rnd 27: (9 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (60) Rnd 28-29: 1 sc in every sc (60) 2 rounds Rnd 30: (8 sc, dec) Rep 6 times (54)

Rnd 31: 1 sc in every sc (54)

Bind off.

Now make 2 suspenders on each side. They should be placed approx. in the center of the pant legs, with 6 sc in between. Every suspender is made with 43 ch. See pictures.





Assembling:

Firmly fill up head and body with filling.

Embroider shoelaces on the shoes as shown in the picture.

Now pull the legs through the pant legs and fold the edge in a bit so they get a bit baggy. Now sew the legs on to rnd no 3 as shown in the picture.







Embroider eyes on between rnd 7 and 8 from the neck with 3 sc between them. Embroider the nose on between rnds 6 and 7 over 3 sc between the eyes. Sew the cap on and the head to the body.

The arms are sewn to the body on rnd 3 counted from the neck and down.

The pant suspenders are sewn on to the front and two buttons are sewn to the front on each suspender.
