Materials, for 3 parts 1 skein of Rainbow Glitter, Gold co. 087

Double pointed needles size 2.5 (3 mm)
Crochet hook 6-B/1 (2 mm)
Knitting mill
4 buttons, Mother of pearl 12 mm Ø, Go Handmade
Elastic band for scrunchie

Yarn quality **Rainbow Glitter**, Hobbii

95% Cotton, 5% Metallic Polyester/
1.75 oz. (50 g) = 175 yds (160 meter)

Gauge 27 sts on 4" (10 cm) stockinette st.

Patterns

Scrunchie

Cast on 140 sts on double pointed needles and knit in the round.

Knit in stockinette st until the work measures 4" (10 cm).

Cast off kw.

Assembling

Sew the cast on- and the cast off edges together using a kitchener st, except for the last 2.8"-3" (7-8 cm).

Cut a piece of elastic of approx. 7.8" (20 cm).

Pull the elastic through the band and sew the ends together.

Close the last piece of the band.

Bracelet and necklace

These can be knit as an i-cord on 2 double pointed needles or on a knitting mill.

On double pointed needles: Cast on 4 sts on 1 double pointed needle, don't turn the work, but push the sts to the opposite end of where the yarn is. Knit with the other needle like this: *k4, don't turn the work, but push the sts to the opposite end*, repeat from * to * until the work measures 13.8" (35 cm) for the bracelet or 23.6" (60 cm) for the necklace. Cast off and cut the yarn with a tail of approx. 20" (50 cm) for buttonhole.

On a knitting mill: Knit a piece of approx. 43.5" (110 cm) that's divided into pieces of approx. 15.8" (40 cm) and 27.5" (70 cm) afterwards, so there's yarn for sewing and crocheting.

Assembling

Sew a button to the cast on edge. On the bracelet another 2 buttons are sewn on next to each other for decoration.

Buttonhole

Crochet approx. 8 ch, pull the end through the st and sew it on at the cast off, so a buttonhole is created.

In the center of the necklace, tie a knot (not too tightly) for decoration.
