



Kawaii Banana

Difficulty: Beginner **Crochet hook:** 3.5 mm **Materials:** Pins, black embroidery thread, safety eyes (6 mm), stuffing, a bit of pink yarn.

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/6 Yellow (#54) - 1 skein Black (#09) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

st(s): stitch(es) ch: chain stitch sc: single crochet 1 incr: make 2 sc in same st 1 decr: make 1 sc through 2 sts sl st: slip stitch

Tip:

Use a stitch marker or a safety pin to mark the beginning of the round. A wooden chopstick is great to have when filling the banana with stuffing.

BANANA

Using Black and a 3.5 mm crochet hook Make a Magic Ring

Round 1: 6 sc into the magic ring (6) Round 2: 6 sc (6)

Switch to Yellow

Round 3: [1 incr] x6 (12) Round 4: 12 sc (12) Round 5: [1 sc, 1 incr] x6 (18) Round 6: 18 sc (18) Round 7: [2 sc, 1 incr] x6 (24) Round 8-25: 24 sc (18 rounds, 24)

Place the safety eyes between rounds 23 and 24 with 4 sts between them.

Embroider a back mouth and pink cheeks.

Round 26: [2 sc, 1 decr] x6 (18) Round 27: 18 sc (18)

Fill the banana with stuffing as you work on.

Round 28: [1 sc, 1 decr] x6 (12) Round 29: 12 sc (12) Round 30: [1 decr] x6 (6) Round 31-33: 6 sc (3 rounds, 6)

Cut the yarn, but leave a long tail end to attach the top piece later.

BANAN TOP PIECE

Using Yellow and a 3.5 mm crochet hook Make a Magic Ring

Round 1: 6 sc into the ring (6) Round 2: [1 incr] x6 (12) Round 3-10: 12 sc (8 rounds, 12)

Fill with stuffing.

Round 11: [1 decr] x6 (6)

Cut the yarn and sew up the small hole at the end.



FINISHING


Place the top pieces onto the banana stem with pins and sew on with the tail end.
