## **Materials**

5 (6, 7, 8) skeins of Snowstorm co. 30 **A** 1 (1, 1, 1) skein of Snowstorm co. 28 **B** 

Circular needle 32" (80 cm)/size 10 (6 mm) and 11 (8 mm)

## Yarn quality

## Snowstorm, Hobbii

100% Wool/ 1,8 oz (50 g) = 55 yds (50 m)

## Gauge

12 sts and 17 rnds on 4" (10 cm) on a size 11 needle (8 mm).

### Size

S (M, L, XL)

### Measurements

Width over the chest: 16½" (18.1", 19.7", 21½") or 42 (46, 50, 54) cm

Length: 19.3" (19.7", 20½", 20.9") or 49 (50, 52,

53) cm

### Pattern information

This is a short and tight fitting model.

The vest is knitted on circular needles to the armhole.

A stribe in a contrast color is knitted across the chest. Armholes and neckband is knitted in reverse stockinette stitch.

## Ribbing

Cast on 84 (94, 104, 114) sts in color **A** on needle no. 10 (6 mm). Knit 3.2" (8 cm) of ribbing: k1, p1.

## **Body**

Switch to needle no. 11 (8 mm) and knit stockinette st.

Knit 4 rnds.

Place a marker in each side = 42 (47, 52, 57) sts on each part = side seams.

## Increasing round

\*Knit to 2 sts before marker, yo, k4, yo\*, rep \*-\* one more time = 4 yarn overs

On the next round the yarn overs are knitted through back loop only.

Knit 7 rnds of stockinette st all in all.

Knit these 8 rnds all in all 4 times = 100 (110, 120, 130) sts.

Knit straight up until the work measures 8.6" (8.6", 9", 9") or 22 (22, 23, 23) cm.

Switch to color B and knit 2" (5 cm). Switch to color A.

Place a marker in each side = 50 (55, 60, 65) sts on each part = side seams.

#### Arm holes

On the next rnd, cast off sts for armholes like this:

\*knit to 3 (4, 5, 6) sts before the marker in the side seam, cast off 6 (7, 8, 9) sts\*, rep

\*-\* one more time, finish kntting the rnd = 44 (48, 52, 56) sts on each part.

#### Back

Knit back over the 44 (48, 52, 56) sts and set the remainins sts aside.

1st row, ws: purl.

**2nd row, rs:** k2tog tbl, knit until 2 sts left, k2tog = 42 (46, 50, 54) sts.

Rep these 2 rows another 1 (2, 3, 4) times = 40 (42, 44, 46) sts.

Knit straight up until the armhole measures 7.1"  $(7\frac{1}{2}$ ", 7.9", 8.3") or 18 (19, 20, 21) cm. Finish on a ws row.

**NB** cast off the shoulder sts and place the sts for the neck on a stitch holder like this:

#### Shoulder

**RS**: cast off 10 (11, 12, 13) sts, finish the row.

**WS:** cast off 10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

#### Neck

Place the remaining 20 (20, 20, 20) sts on a stitch holder for neck.

### Front

Attach yarn and knit from the ws.

1st row, ws: purl.

**2nd row, rs:** k2tog tbl, knit to 2 sts left, k2tog = 42 (46, 50, 54) sts.

Rep these 2 rows another 1 (2, 3, 4) times = 40 (42, 44, 46) sts.

Knit straight up until the work measures 13.8" (14.2", 15", 15.4") or 35 (36, 38, 39) cm. Finish on a ws row.

### Neckline

RS: Knit 15 (16, 17, 18) sts, set the remaining sts aside.



#### Left side

WS: purl

**RS:** k to 2 sts left, k2tog.

Rep these 2 rows until you have 10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

Knit straight up until the arm hole measures 7.9" (8.3", 8.7", 9") or 20 (21, 22, 23) cm.

Place a marker in the sleeve side = shoulder.

Knit another 0.8" (2 cm) straight up. Finish on a ws row.

Cast off.

Place 10 (10, 10, 10) sts on a stitch holder.

### Right side

**RS:** knit the 15 (16, 17, 18) sts kw.

WS: purl

RS: k2tog tbl, finish the row.

Rep the last 2 rows until you have 10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

Knit straight up until the armhole measures 7.9" (8.3", 8.7", 9") or 20 (21, 22, 23) cm.

Place a marker in the sleeve side = shoulder.

Knit another 0.8" (2 cm) straight up. Finish on a ws row.

Cast off.

## Assembling and edges

Sew up the shoulder seams.

#### **Armbands**

Knit up approx 50 (52, 54, 56) sts from the rs in the armhole.

Knit p from the rs (= reversed stockinette st) around (using Magic Loop).

All in all knit 4 rnds.

Cast off pw.

#### **Neckline**

Place the 20 sts in the neck on needle no. 10 (6 mm), knit up sts from the rs, knit the 10 sts of the neckline and knit up sts so you have 66-70 sts in the neckline.

Knit p from the rs (= reversed stockinette st) around (using Magic Loop).

All in all knit 4 rnds.

Cast off pw.
