Materials

1 skein of Twister Solid, co. 101
Circular needle 32" (80 cm) / sz 2.5 (3.0 mm)
Crochet hook C/D 2/3 (3.0 mm)
1 button
Stitch markers

Yarn quality

 **Twister Solid**, Hobbii
55% cotton, 45% acrylic / 3.5 oz (100 g) = 437
yds (400 meter)

Gauge

26 sts and 26 rows on 4" (10 cm) in pattern.

Size

Child - 2-6 yrs (8-12, 14-16 yrs)

Measurements

Width in the neckline: 14.2" (15", 15.8") or 36 (38,
40) cm
Bottom width: 39.4" (44.1", 47.2") or 100 (112, 120)
cm
Height: 5.5" or 14 cm

Pattern information

The collar is knitted top-down.
The edges is knitted in garter st.
It is a lace patterns with increases.

Explanations

Est A = edge stitch A

sl1 kw, k3.

Est B = edge stitch B

k3, k1tbl.

Inc = increase

Pick up horizontal loop before next st and knit into back of it.

SSK = 2 sts kw tog tilting left

Slip 1 st kw and slip another st kw, put left needle through these 2 sts with the tip in front of the work and knit them together kw.

Pattern

Neckband

Cast on 80 (86, 92) sts.

1st row: Est A, knit to 4 sts left, Est B.

Rep 1st row until the border measures 0.4" or 1 cm. Finish on a rs-row.

Pattern 1

1st row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

2nd row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k2tog, (yo, k1) 2 times, k2tog*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B.

3rd row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

4th row: Est A, knit to 4 sts left, Est B.

5th row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

6th row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k2tog, (yo, k1) 2 times, k2tog*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B.

7th row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

8th row: Est A, k3, *k1, inc, k4, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est B.

Pattern 2

1st row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

2nd row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2 times, k2tog, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B.

3rd row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

4th row: Est A, k3, *k1, inc, k6, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est B.

Pattern 3

1st row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

2nd row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 4 times, k2tog, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B.

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

4th row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

5th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

6th row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *(k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1), 4 times, k2tog, k2tog*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B**.

7th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

8th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k10, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B**.

Pattern 4

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 4 times, (k2tog) 2 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B**.

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

4th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k12, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B**.

Pattern 5

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 2 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B**.

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

4th row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

5th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

6th row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *(k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B**.

7th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

8th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k16, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B**.

Pattern 6

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B**.

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

4th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k18, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B**.

Outer edge

1st row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

Rep 1st row until the edge measures 0.4" or 1 cm. Finish on a ws-row.

Cast off – not too tightly.

Buttonhole

The buttonhole is crocheted as a bridle on the right side of the collar, on the outside of the edge.

Work 1 sl st on the neckband, work 6-7 ch, work 1 sl st in the neckband of the collar. Bind off.

Sew on the button on the left side.
