

## Kvarts - Shadow shawl

## Materials

3 balls BabyWool, col. 06 (color A)
3 balls BabyWool, col. 14 (color B)
Circular needle $80 \mathrm{~cm} /$ size 4 mm
Stitch markers
Blocking mats
Blocking wires and -pins
Yarn
BabyWool, Happy Sheep
$100 \%$ wool/ $50 \mathrm{~g}=165$ meters

## Gauge

20 stitches x 36 rows on 10 cm in pattern before washing

## Size

One size

## Measurements

Width: 170 cm
Length: 75 cm

## Pattern information

This shawl is worked top down. You work back and forth on a circular needle in shadow knitting with 2 colors.
Pres or block the shawl on blocking mats, ensuring the edge doesn't curl.

## Pattern

## Edge

CO 41 stitches with color A and work back and forth on the circular needle.
Knit 2 rows.
Insert a marker on each side of the middle stitch (MS).

## Continue with increasing and shadow knitting as follows:

$\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ row, RS: Color B, k2, M1 by picking up the thread between 2 stitches and knit tbl, knit until stitch marker, M1, work MS in knit stitch, M1, knit until there are 2 stitches left, M1 and k2 $=4$ stitches increased.
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row, WS: Color B, knit until stitch marker, work MS in knit stitch and purl until there are 2 stitches left, k2.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row, RS: Color A, k2, M1, knit until stitch marker, M1, work MS in knit stitch, M1, knit until there are 2 stitches left, M1 and $\mathrm{k} 2=4$ stitches increased.
$4^{\text {th }}$ row, WS: Color A, k2, purl until stitch marker, work MS in knit stitch and knit the rest of the row.

Repeat these 4 rows until the shawl measures just about 75 cm , measured along the middle stitch.
Knit to 2 more rows with color B. Bind off loosely.

## Finish

Pres or block the shawl on blocking mats, to ensure the edge doesn't curl.
