



# Lone - Slipover

No. 2004-203-3326

## Materials

2 (3, 3, 4, 4) Magic Sock Wool col. 26  
4 (4, 5, 5, 6) skeins Kid Silk col. 28

Single pointed needle 4 mm  
Circular needle 80 cm/ 4 mm for the edges  
Stitch markers  
Stitch holder

## Yarn

**Magic Sock Wool**, Happy Sheep  
70% S/W Wool, 30% Nylon/100 g = 400 meters  
**Kid Silk**, Hobbii  
70% Kid Mohair, 30% Silk/25 g = 195 meters

## Gauge

23 stitches x 32 rounds/ rows  
= 10 cm in stockinette stitch with 1 strand of each  
quality

## Size

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

## Measurement

Width: 44 (48, 52, 56, 60) cm  
Length: 51 (52, 53, 54, 55) cm, measured  
at sleeve

## Pattern information

You work with 1 strand of each quality =  
2 strands. The slipover is worked bottom  
up.  
Neck and sleeve edges are worked in rib  
and folded to WS.

## Back piece

CO 101 (111, 121, 131, 141) stitches.

### Rib edge

**1<sup>st</sup> row, WS:** p1, \*k1, p1\*, repeat \*-\* on entire row.

**2. row, RS:** k1, \*p1, k1\*, repeat \*-\* on entire row.

Repeat these 2 rows.

Work 4 cm rib edge.

### Body

Continue in stockinette stitch until piece measures 33 (33, 33, 33, 33) cm. Finish with a WS row.

### Armhole

BO 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) stitches in the beginning of the next 2 rows = 89 (97, 105, 113, 121) stitches.

### Decrease for armhole on both sides

**RS:** k1, k2tog tbl, continue in knit stitch until there are 3 stitches left, k2tog, k1 = 2 stitches decreased.

**WS:** Purl all stitches.

Continue decreasing like this in every RS row until you have a total of 79 (81, 85, 89, 93) stitches.

Continue until piece measures 50 (51, 52, 53, 54) cm.

Bind off all stitches.

**Please note!** The front piece is worked 2 cm longer, so the seam will be more on the back piece.

## Front piece

Work as back piece until the 79 (81, 85, 89, 93) stitches.

Then continue until piece measures 45 (46, 47, 47, 48) cm. Finish with a RS row.

### Neck edge

#### Right side

**1<sup>st</sup> row, WS:** p34 (35, 36, 38, 39) stitches, turn (remaining stitches are not worked).

**2<sup>nd</sup> row, RS:** BO 5 stitches, work rest of row in knit stitches.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row, WS:** purl all stitches.

**4<sup>th</sup> row, RS:** BO 4 stitches, work rest of row in knit stitches.

**5<sup>th</sup> row, WS:** purl all stitches.

**6<sup>th</sup> row, RS:** BO 3 stitches, work rest of row in knit stitches.

**7<sup>th</sup> row, WS:** purl all stitches.

**8<sup>th</sup> row, RS:** BO 2 stitches, work rest of row in knit stitches.

**9<sup>th</sup> row, WS:** purl.

**10<sup>th</sup> row, RS:** BO 1 stitch, work rest of row in knit stitches = 19 (20, 21, 23, 24) stitches for the shoulder.

Continue until piece measures 52 (53, 54, 55, 56) cm.

Finish with a RS row.

### Neck

**WS:** purl until there's 1 stitch left in neck, yo, p1.

**RS:** knit all stitches and work yo tbl.

Repeat these 2 rows a total of 3 times = 22 (23, 24, 26, 27) stitches.

Purl 1 row.

Bind off.

### Neckline

Slip the middle 11 (11, 13, 13, 15) stitches on a stitch holder.

**Please note** Attach yarn and work the left shoulder.

### Left shoulder

**1<sup>st</sup> row, WS:** p 34 (35, 36, 38, 39) stitches.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row, RS:** knit all stitches

**3. row, WS:** BO 5 stitches, work rest of row in purl stitches.

**4. row, RS:** knit all stitches.

**5. row, WS:** BO 4 stitches, work rest of row in purl stitches.

**6. row, RS:** knit all stitches

**7. row, WS:** BO 3 stitches, work rest of row in purl stitches.

**8. row, RS:** knit all stitches.

**9. row, WS:** BO 2 stitches, work rest of row in purl stitches.

**10. row, RS:** knit all stitches.

**11. row, WS:** BO 1 stitch, work rest of row in purl stitches = 19 (20, 21, 23, 24) stitches for the shoulder.

Continue until piece measures 52 (53, 54, 55, 56) cm. Finish with a WS row.

**Please note:** Increase in the neck to ensure a good fitting.

### Neck

**RS:** knit until there's 1 stich left, yo, k1.

**WS:** purl all stitches and work the yo tbl.

Repeat these 2 rows a total of 3 times = 22 (23, 24, 26, 27) stitches.

Knit 1 row.

Bind off.

### Shoulders

Sew the shoulders together in Kitchener stitch.

Graft the side seams together.

## Edges

Pick up approx. 23 stitches for every 10 cm on the edges.

### Neck edge

Using the circular needle, pick up approx. 130 (134, 138, 142, 146) stitches around the neckline. Begin in the middle on the back piece and work in the round using the Magic loop-technique.

Work 4 cm rib, k1, p1.

Bind off loosely in rib.

Fold edge around on WS and sew it on.

### Armhole edge

Using the circular needle, pick up approx. 110 (120, 130, 140, 150) stitches around the armhole. Begin at side and work in the round using the Magic loop-technique.

Work 4 cm rib, k1, p1.

Bind off loosely in rib.

Fold edge around on WS and sew it on.

Work and assembly the other armhole edge in the same way.
