



Primula - Vest

Materials

2, (2, 2, 2, 3) skeins of Baby Cotton Organic, co. 03

Needle sz 2.5 (3 mm)

Stitch holder

Stitch markers

2 (3, 3, 3, 3) buttons, Ufo Ø 15 mm

Yarn quality

Baby Cotton Organic, Hobbii

100% egyptian cotton/ 1.75 oz (50 g) = 186 yds (170 meter)

Gauge

26 sts and 35 rows on 4" (10 cm) pattern.

Sizes

Premature-0 (0-3, 3-6, 6-9, 9-12) months.

Measurements

Width: 7.9" (8.7", 9.4", 10.2", 11") or 20 (22, 24, 26, 28) cm

Length: 10.6" (11.4", 12.2", 13.4", 14.2") or 27 (29, 31, 34, 36) cm

Pattern information

The vest is knitted back and forth on the needles in one piece and is finally sewn together in the sides for armholes.

Buttonband and button holes are made as you go.

Tip

Place a marker after and before the knit-stitches on each side.

Pattern

NB Where only 1 number is written, this goes for all sizes.

Chart

Knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side

Purl on the right side, knit on the wrong side

Front

Cast on 52 (58, 62, 68, 72) sts and knit back and forth.

Knit 9 rows.

Right side: Knit over the outer 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) sts on each side and by chart over the center 44 (48, 52, 56, 60) sts on all rows.

Knit until the work measures 7½" (7.9", 8.3", 8.7", 9") or 19 (20, 21, 22, 23) cm.

Place a marker in each side of the work = mark for armholes.

Buttonband

Now separate the front so a buttonband with buttonholes and neckline is created.

Knit 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) sts kw and 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts by chart. The remaining sts are set to rest.

Right front

Knit 6 sts kw for buttonband, 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts by chart, 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) sts kw.

Knit back and forth using knit sts and by chart until the buttonband measures 2.4" (2.7", 3.1", 3.5", 4") or 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) cm, while knitting the buttonholes.

NB knit 2 (3, 3, 3, 3) buttonholes, first buttonhole is knitted after 0.8" (0.4", 0.4", 0.4", 0.4") or 2 (1, 1, 1, 1) cm and the next with a 0.8" (0.8", 0.8", 0.8", 1") or 2 (2, 2, 2, 2½) cm space between each one.

From the right side, knit buttonholes like this: k2, cast off 2 sts, knit the rest of the row as previously described. On the next row, cast on 2 sts over the bound off sts using a knitted cast on.

Neck

From the right side (towards the neck), cast off 12 (12, 12, 13, 14) sts kw.
Knit 1.2" (1.6", 1.6", 2", 2.4") or 3 (4, 4, 5, 6) cm straight up over the remaining 17 (20, 22, 24, 25) sts.

NB The outer st towards the neck is knit (kw) on all rows.
Finish with a wrongside-row, set the sts to rest.

Left front

Place the resting sts for left front back on the needle and knit from the wrong side.
6 sts up in the buttonband, 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts by chart, k 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) sts.
Knit back and forth in k sts and by chart until the buttonband measures 2.4" (2.8", 3.1", 3.5", 4") or 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) cm.

Neck

From the wrong side (towards the neck), cast off 12 (12, 12, 13, 14) sts pw.
Knit 1.2" (1.6", 1.6", 2", 2.4") or 3 (4, 4, 5, 6) cm straight up over the remaining 17 (20, 22, 24, 25) sts.
Make sure the pattern fits.

NB The outer st towards the neck is knit (kw) on all rows.

Neck and back

After the last knitrow cast on 18 (18, 18, 20, 22) sts using a knitted cast on.
Continue over the resting sts = 52 (58, 62, 68, 72) sts.
Knit back and forth until the back measures 9" (9.9", 10.6", 11.4", 12.2") or 23 (25, 27, 29, 31) cm measures from the neck.
Knit 9 rows.
Cast off.

Assembling

Sew the sides together up to the mark at the armhole.
Attach buttons across from the buttonholes.
