

## Smoothie - Baskets

## Materials:

Baby Snuggle color no. 30
PU leather base 17 and 20 cm - Lavender
Crochet hook 5
2 straps for basket $8.5 \times 1.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ - Lavender 2 screw rivets 14 mm
Screwdriver 2.0
Size: Small (Large)

Measurements: Approx.
Diameter: 20 (23) cm
Height: 8 (9) cm
Yarn usage: Approx. 100 (115) g

## Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain
M: Stitch
Sc: Single crochet
SI st: Slip stitch
BI: Back loop

## Pattern - Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

Note. All rounds start with a ch 1 . This does not count as a st, neither does it count towards the st total.
The rounds end with a sl st, which is worked in the first sc.
The baskets are crocheted with two threads. They must be crocheted with a firm gauge to make the sidepieces stable and avoid holes.

1. Loop the yarn through a hole in the leather base and work 2 sc . Work 2 sc in each hole to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 76 (88)
2. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=76$ (88)
3. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the bl of each st to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=76(88)$
4. Ch 1. "Work 1 sc in the first $\mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the bl of the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=76(88)$

Repeat round 4 until you have a total of 7 (8) pattern rounds.

## Last round:

Ch 1. Work a sl st in the bl of each st to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=76(88)$ Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

## Photo tutorial:

## Round 1



1. Loop the yarn through a hole in the leather base.

2. Work 2 sc in the hole.

3. Work 2 sc in each hole to the end of the round.

## Round 2


5. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 76 (88)

## Round 3


6. Ch 1.

4. End with a sl st. $=76$ (88)

7. Work 1 sc in the bl of the first st.

8. Like this.

9. Work 1 sc in the bl of each st to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 76 (88)

## Round 4


10. Ch 1.

12. Work 1 sc in the bl of the next st".

11. "Work 1 sc in the first st.

13. Like this.

14. "Work 1 sc in the next st.

16. Like this.

18. End with a sl st. $=76$ (88)

15. Work 1 sc in the bl of the next st".

17. "Work 1 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the bl of the following st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round.

## Round 5


19. This round is a repetition of round 4 . Ch
1.

21. Work 1 sc in the bl of the next st".

23. "Work 1 sc in the first st, 1 sc in the bl of the next st".

20. "Work 1 sc in the first st.

22. Like this.

24. Repeat "to" to the end of the round.


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25. End with a sl st. $=76$ (88)

## Round 6 and onwards


26. Repeat round 4 until you have a total of 7 (8) pattern rounds.

## Last round


27. Ch 1.

28. Work a sl st in the bl of the first st.

29. Like this.

31. End with a sl st. $=76$ (88)

## Attaching the PU strap and the screw

 rivet
33. Attach the PU strap by folding it over the edge of the basket. Use the screw rivet to secure it.

30. Work a sl st in the bl of each st to the end of the round.

32. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

34. Like this.
