



Kila - Tote

Materiales

3 skeins Rainbow 8/6, col 56

Circular needle 3.5 mm/ 80 cm or double pointed needles 3.5 mm Markers

Yarn

Rainbow 8/6, Hobbii 100% cotton/ 50 g = 105 m

Knitting gauge

20 sts og 30 rows for 10 cm stockinette

Measurements

Height: 34 cm without straps

Width: 27 cm Stretches in use.

Pattern information

The tote bottom is worked in the round as a flat circle, using the magic loop technique. Then it is worked straight up with a pattern. The straps are made last.

Magic loop

I-cord: *knit 5, slip sts back into the left needle*. Repeat between **.

Stockinette stitch: Knit on right side, purl on wrong side.

Pattern instructions

Cast on 8 sts on a circular needle with a long tail end and work in the round using the magic loop technique.

Place a marker at the beginning of the round.

Bottom

Round 1: *k1, yo*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 2: *k1, k1 tbl of the yo*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 3: *k2, yo*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 4: k, k the yos tbl.

Round 5: *k3, yo*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 6: k, k the yos tbl.

Round 7: *k4, yo*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 8: k, k the yos tbl.

Continue in this manner until there are 10 sts between the increases = 88 sts on the needles.

End with a k round.

Sides

Continue in pattern like so:

Round 1: *yo, k2tog*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 2: knit.

Round 3: *k2tog, yo*, repeat between ** until end of round.

Round 4: knit.

Repeat these 4 rounds until the patterned part measures 25 cm from the last round of the bottom.

Edge

Work 5 rounds of stockinette.

k5 and place those sts on a stitch holder, bind off 15 sts, k5 and place those sts on a stitch holder, bind off 19 sts, repeat between **.

NB Last st is bound off over the first st of the round.

Straps

Make an i-cord over the first 5 sts on a stitch holder using the magic loop technique or double pointed needles, until the strap measures 48 cm, not stretched.

Sew the strap onto the next 5 sts on a stitch holder (over the 15 bound off sts)

Make another strap in the same manner.

Finishing

Sew up the hole at the bottom with the long tail end.
